

Frequently asked questions for call 84/G/ENT/SAT/13/7028 — Support to internat. activities: Information, Training and Assistance Centre for the European GNSS programmes in Latin America

This document contains questions regarding the call **84/G/ENT/SAT/13/7028** submitted to the Helpdesk (ENTR-CFP-13-7028-SAT@ec.europa.eu).

1. In the text of the call it is stated that private entities, among others, are eligible to participate. I would like to ask you if private universities fall under this category, according to the call. Can public universities participate at all?

Public universities are eligible for participation.

2. Can an entity based in Peru submit a proposal?

In accordance with 5.1 of the call for proposal only applications from legal entities established in one of the following countries are eligible

- EU Member States
- Brazil, Argentina, Chile.

3. According to the information displayed on the web it was first published on 19/07/2013, and you set the deadline on 19/09/2013, so that means a total of 2 months for writing up the proposal, which I believe is more than enough. However I would like to point out the fact that most of Spanish companies DO have their summertime vacation during whole August. Therefore, could you please consider postponing the deadline to mid-October?

Unfortunately it is not possible to postpone the deadline.

4. May, for example, a company based in Germany apply in the call with the intention to take the opportunity to participate in the current Call for Proposal having as targeted country Peru?

Companies based in the European Union, in Argentina, Brazil and Chile are eligible. The applicant is expected to have operations in the EU and in the targeted countries/regions of Latin America: Argentina, Brazil and Chile. Applicants having also operations in Peru will not be excluded.

5. Will be eligible to participate an applicant based in the EU if its proposal has the objective to promote the European GNSS technologies and will perform actions and operations in any other country in South America but NOT in the three targeted countries (Argentina, Brazil and Chile)?

In other words, has the participating entity to perform the actions and operations proposed within this programm ONLY in the 3 targeted countries?

The work to be carried out and the GNSS programmes to promote, should be undertaken ONLY in the targeted countries or can be done in any other country in South America?

Companies based in the European Union, in Argentina, Brazil and Chile are eligible. Applicants are expected to have operations in at least in one of the targeted countries Argentina, Brazil or Chile. Applicants proposing also operations in other Latin American countries will not be excluded.

6. I talk in a conference about Galileo system and the public looks so interest that I would like promoted it. Many representative and investors ask me for it. I would like to know how I could do to reach this proposal. I believe that If we promoted it in the correct place with the right people everybody will know it and the system increase the users and the investors.

Please consult the eligibility criteria set out in the call for proposal to assess whether you are eligible to participate in this call for proposals as well as the guide for applicants setting out the procedures for preparing a proposal.

7. We received an invitation to present a proposal during last week. We are very interested on participate of this program. The problem is that due to the fact that we knew last week about this program and that Chile celebrates his national holiday during this week, we are not going to be able to present all the documents needed before September 19th. Is there any possibility of having more time to present all the paper work?

It is not possible to postpone the deadline. Please note that the deadline for submission is 19/09/2013, 17:00 (Brussels time) as mentioned in the Call text.
