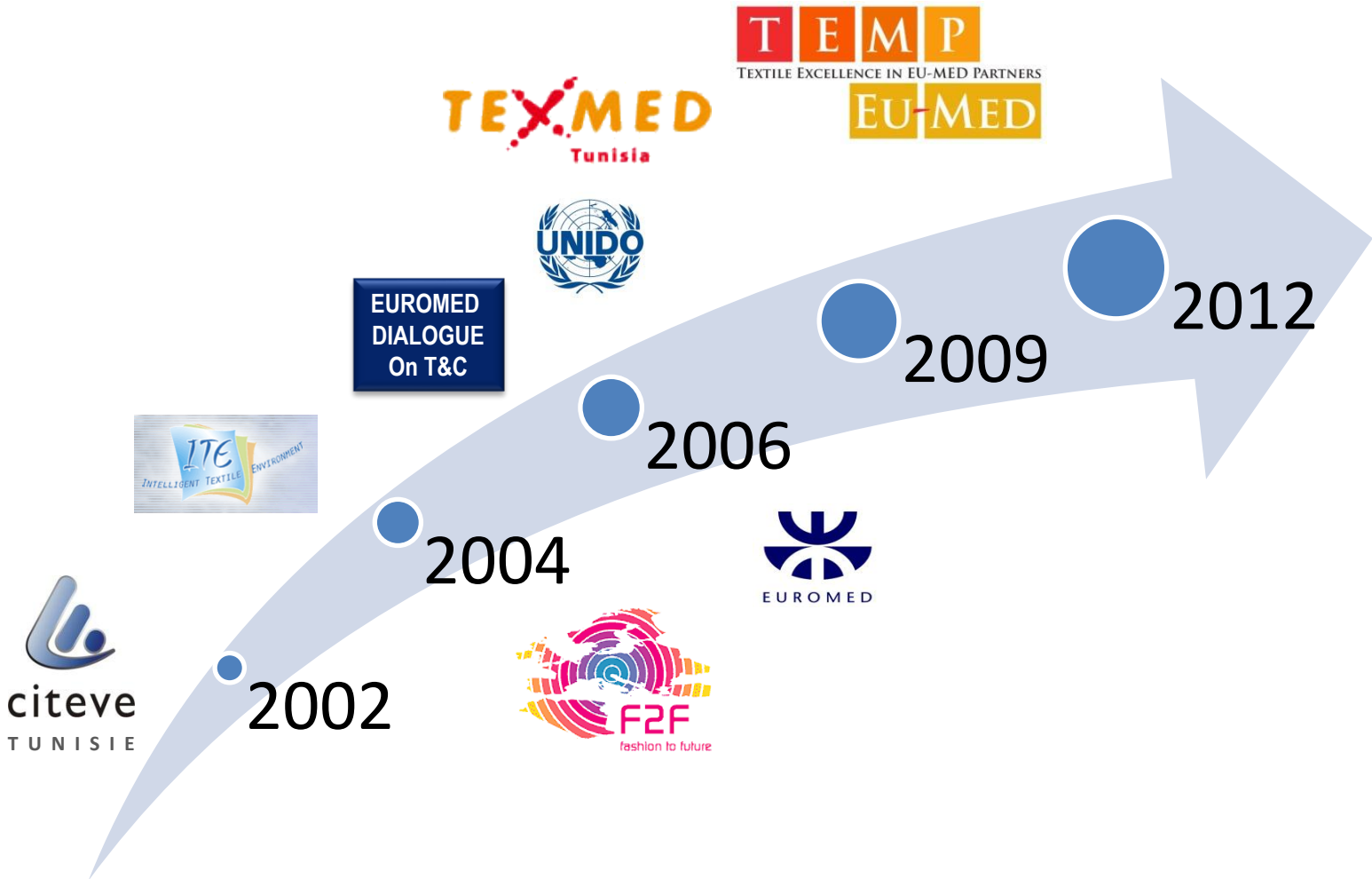

- ✓ Create a **contact platform** with other scientific fields of knowledge or even other industrial sectors aiming to improve contacts within the fashion industry along the partner's countries



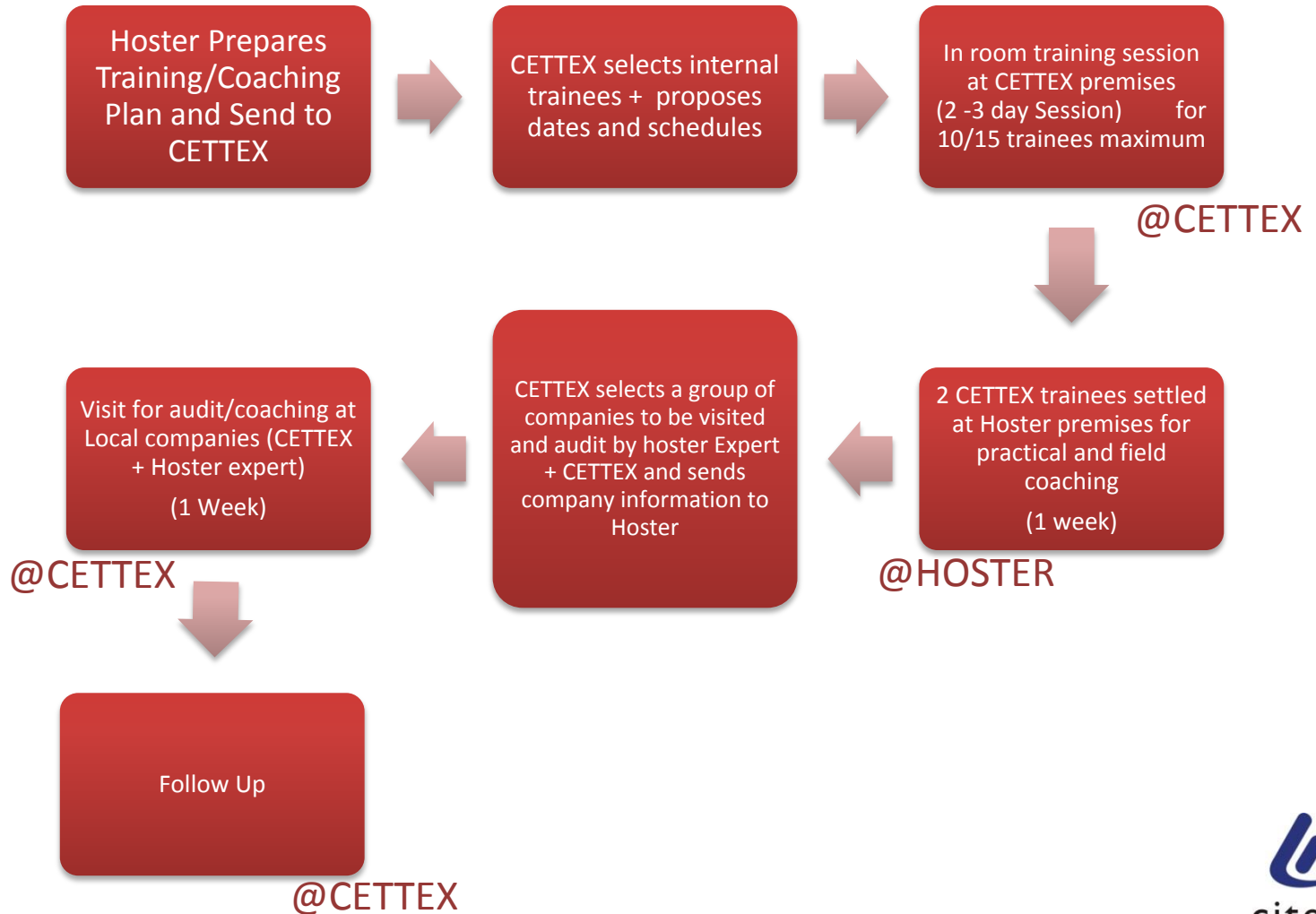

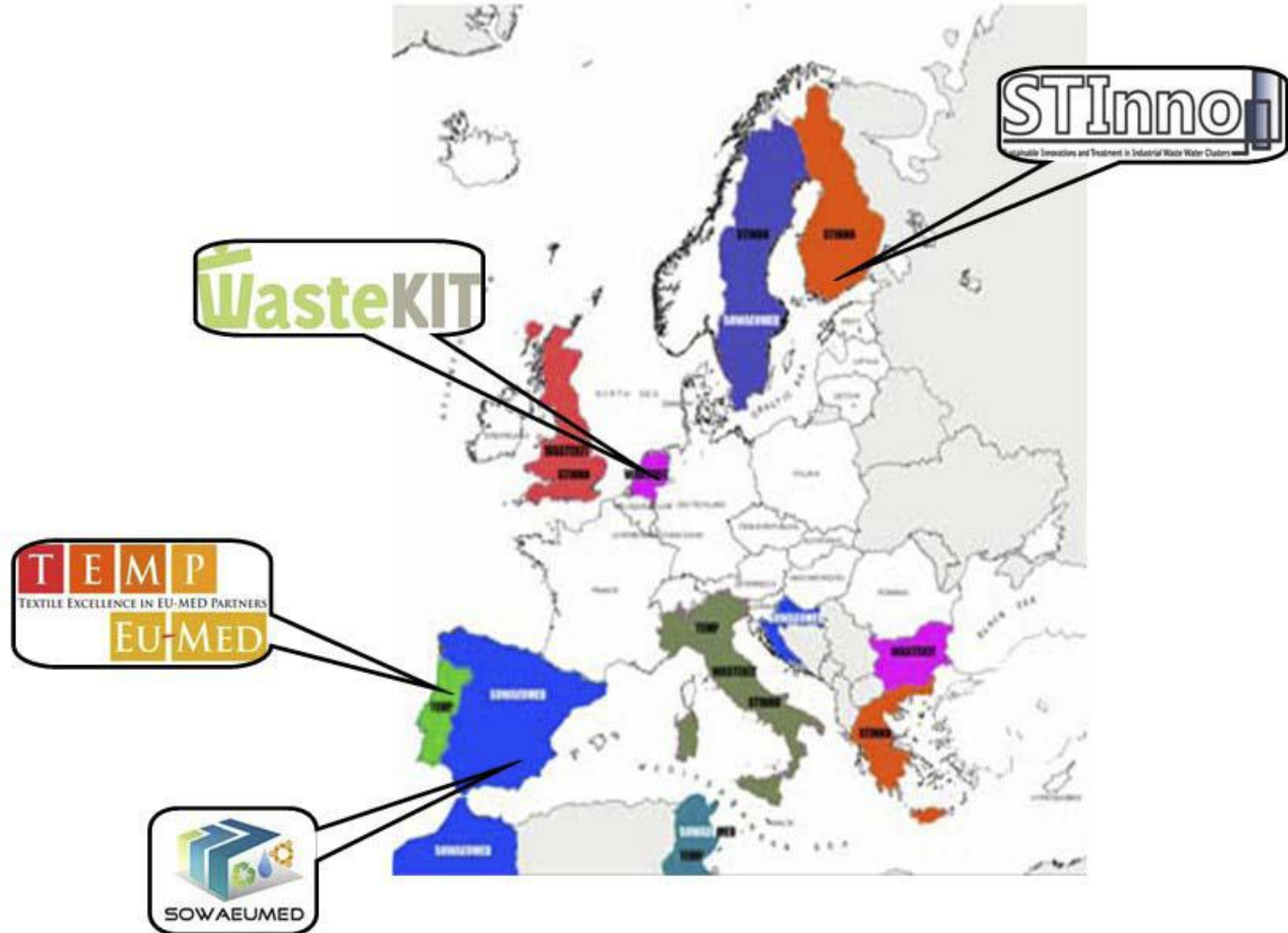
