

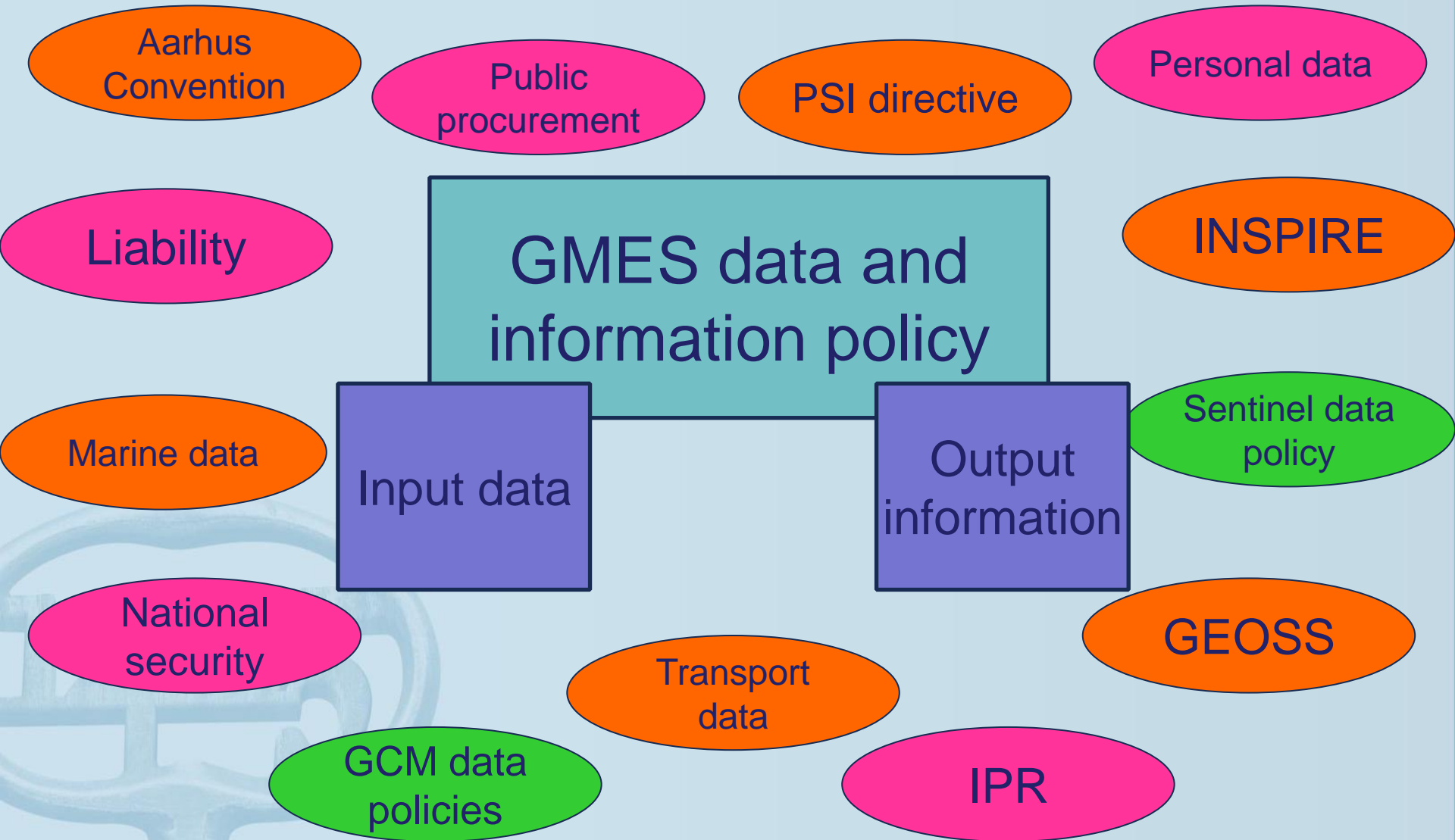

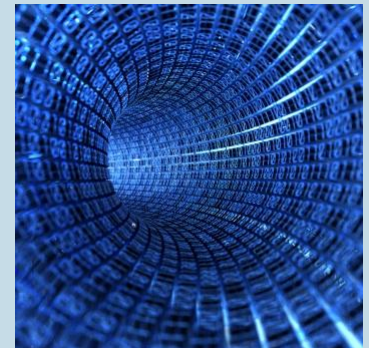

GMES regulation

- Data and information policy
 - Full and **open** access to information produced by GMES services and data collected through GMES infrastructure
 - **Subject to** relevant international agreements, security restrictions and licensing conditions, including registration and acceptance of user licences
 - Imposing restrictions
 - Imposing availability?



INSPIRE directive

- Sharing spatial data sets and services between public authorities, for public tasks that may have an impact on the environment



PSI directive

- 34 data themes
- Metadata, interoperability, network services, data sharing, coordination (+ monitoring & reporting)

INSPIRE directive (2)

- MS have to adopt measures for the sharing of spatial data sets and services between their public authorities
 - No practical obstacles at the point of use
 - Licensing and charging
 - Fully compatible with the general aim of facilitating sharing
 - Minimum required to ensure the necessary quality and supply, together with a reasonable return on investment
 - Respect for self-financing requirements
 - Limitations : course of justice, public security, national defence, international relations

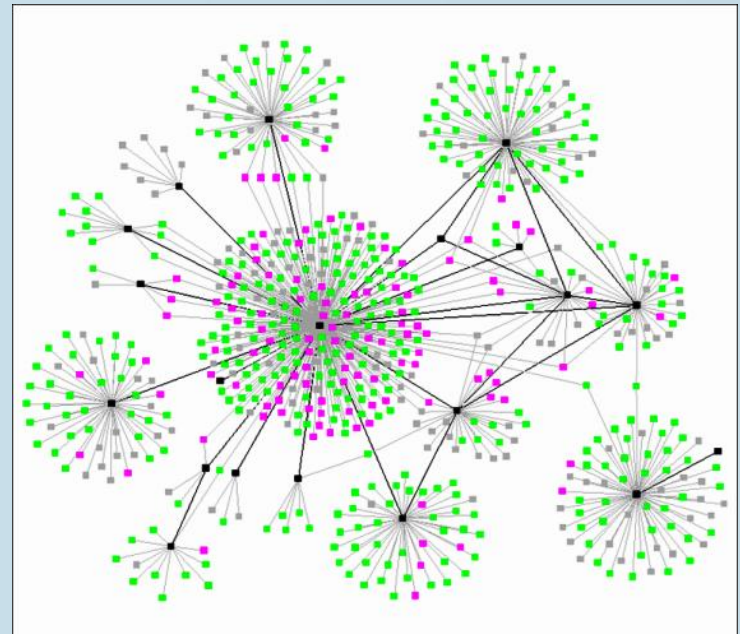
INSPIRE directive (3)

- Institutions and bodies of the Community/Union
 - National arrangements
 - Regulation 268/10
 - Harmonised conditions of access
 - Limitations
 - Contractors
- Bodies established by international agreements
 - “On a reciprocal and equivalent basis”



INSPIRE directive (4)

- Member States have to create a network of services
 - Discovery, view, download, transformation, invoking
 - Available to the public
 - Limitations on public access
 - Charges



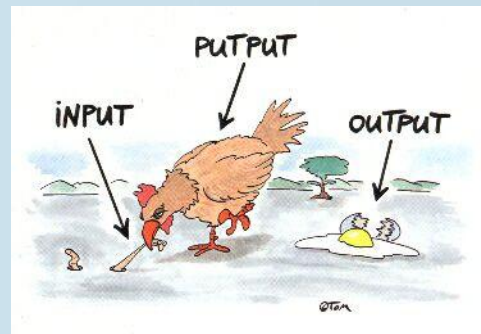
Aarhus Convention + directive 2003/4

- Public access to environmental information
 - Active dissemination
 - Progressive availability of information in electronic databases
 - Access on request
 - No obligation to state an interest
 - Limited grounds of refusal
 - International relations, public security or national defence
 - Restrictive interpretation
 - Weighing of interests



Relevance

- Input data
 - Sharing and licensing agreements under INSPIRE
 - Sublicensing + redistribution
 - Added-value products and services
- Output information
 - Sharing and licensing agreements under INSPIRE (if input data is necessary)
 - Public access to environmental information
