- Guidelines agreed by Sherpas
- Call closed on 7 February 2014
- 90 commitment proposals received
  - **80 "Raw Materials Commitments"**
  - approx. **800 partners**
  - relative deficit of **partners** from EU-13 group
  - Higher number of **technology** commitments
  - Higher number of technology commitments for **primary production** than secondary
  - **Scope** of raw materials covered representative (i.e. metals, industrial, forest-based materials)
- Next calls in 2015, 2017 and 2019

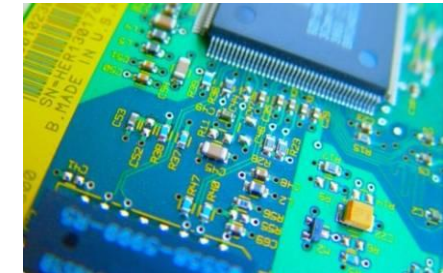
