- § Novelty

- § Deployed at the level with the highest impact

Rules of Participation (I)

- § Eligible participants
 - ü Public authorities or mandated organisations: National/regional organisations responsible for, involved in funding or implementation of innovation programme that could benefit mobile and mobility industries or creative industries companies
 - Other organisations: universities, business associations, consultancies, IT firms, banks, business angels, tourism offices etc. if they provide relevant experience (strands 3, 4, 7 and 8); they may also be involved as subcontractors (all strands) but may only be selected through a competitive procedure after the grant agreement is signed
 - Ü <u>Cluster organisations and national/regional authorities</u> responsible for cluster programme in creative industries (strands 2, 3, 6 and 8)
- § CIP participating countries
 - ü EU 27 + non-EU countries: Albania, Croatia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Iceland, Israel, Liechtenstein, Montenegro, Norway, Serbia and Turkey

Activities

Strands 2 & 6: Better service innovation support

- § Develop and implement a regional / national innovation voucher programme for SMEs
- § Make available professional experience of service providers from at least 3 different regions from 2 CIP countries
- § Type A voucher scheme: address the specific needs of SMEs within own industry to innovate
- § Type B voucher scheme: encourage SMEs from other industries to access innovative services from the industry
- § Offer vouchers for innovation support for a maximum € 5,000
- § Organise networking and matchmaking
- § Participate in policy learning on transnational voucher schemes

Financing Scheme

Strands 2 & 6: Better service innovation support

- § More than one project per strand to fund
- § Maximum EU co-financing ceiling per project

§Strand 2: € 250.000 each (2-3 projects) §Strand 6: € 250.000 each (3-5 projects)

§ Maximum overall reimbursement 75% of eligible costs and

§voucher up to a total €100,000 eligible costs for which max. 95% reimbursement

§maximum reimbursement rate 65% of eligible costs other than vouchers

§ Project duration: only 24 months

Strand 3: Large scale demonstrators

- § Promote sustainable tourism in rural areas
- § Establish a task force to investigate and map scope for innovative mobile services
- § Develop masterplan, roadmap and implementing guidelines
- § Implement mobile service application(s) in practice
- § Promote and signpost activities to raise awareness

Financing Scheme

Strand 3: Large scale demonstrators

- § Up to two projects
- § Maximum EU co-financing ceiling per project §Strand 3: € 500.000 each
- § Maximum overall reimbursement 75% of eligible costs
- § Project duration: only 24 months

Activities

Strands 4 & 7: Better access to finance

- § Provide a mapping of existing financial opportunities
- § Improve the investment-readiness of companies in the industries through testing customised training and coaching
- § Raise investors' awareness & readiness to invest in industries
- § Mobilise additional funding for companies e.g. by setting up a pan-European venture capital fund or promoting crowd funding

Financing Scheme

Strands 4 & 7: Better access to finance

- § Only one project for strand 4 & two projects for strand 7
- § Maximum EU co-financing ceiling per project

§Strand 4: € 1.500.000

§Strand 7: € 1.250.000 each (2 projects)

- § Maximum overall reimbursement 65% of eligible costs
- § Project duration: 36 months

Activities

Strand 8: Cluster excellence & cooperation

- § Promote the quality of creative cluster management
- § Better involve SMEs in creative industries clusters
- § Facilitate cross-sectoral linkages and cooperation within creative industries and with others industries
- § Support the internationalisation of cluster activities
- § Encourage clustering and cluster incubation

Financing Scheme

Strand 8: Cluster excellence & cooperation

- § Two projects
- § Maximum EU co-financing ceiling per project §Strand 8: € 1.250.000 each
- § Maximum overall reimbursement 50% of eligible costs
- § Project duration: 36 months

Potential Impact and Indicators

Potential impact, quality, relevance, visibility and cost-effectiveness

- § Additional funds mobilised directly through the initiative and expected indirect impact in terms of additional public or private funding (leverage effect)
- § New ideas for better innovation support services that are novel, replicable, usable, scalable and adaptable
- § Number of companies supported or benefitting from action directly (e.g. voucher, coaching, training)
- § Positive spill-over effects into other industries due to better valorisation of creative and innovative mobile service potential
- § European added value of activities and cooperation with related initiatives
- § Contribution to development a world-class industrial base in Europe
