The entry form is made of the following 8 questions.

1. Project name (10 words max).
2. Tweet your idea! (140 characters).
3. Choose the field to which your idea relates mainly.

4. Provide a summary of your idea, highlighting how it solves a social need or societal issue (200 words max).
5. Explain why your idea is innovative in the context and in the country where it will be implemented. Alternatively, if your idea is based on an existing concept, explain how your idea differs from this. (200 words max).
6. Describe clearly how your idea is expected to have an impact (200 words max).
7. Indicate at what scale your idea will operate initially and how it could be implemented at a larger scale and in another region or EU Member State in the future (200 words max).
8. Specify how your idea could be sustained over the next three years (200 words max).
