26 MS were present; CY was absent and represented by EL for the vote.

**1. DRAFT CODIFICATION AND RECAST OF REGULATION (EC) NO 639/2003 LAYING DOWN DETAILED RULES PURSUANT TO COUNCIL REGULATION (EC) NO 1254/1999 AS REGARDS REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GRANTING OF EXPORT REFUNDS RELATED TO THE WELFARE OF LIVE BOVINE ANIMALS DURING TRANSPORT:**

Commission Regulation (EC) No 639/2003 of 9 April 2003 laying down detailed rules pursuant to Council Regulation (EC) No 1254/1999 as regards requirements for the granting of export refunds related to the welfare of live bovine animals during transport has been substantially amended several times. Since further amendments are to be made, it should be recast in the interests of clarity.

Result of the vote: favorable opinion (306 votes in favor and 39 abstentions)

**2. DRAFT COMMISSION DECISION ON THE DETERMINATION OF SURPLUS STOCKS OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS OTHER THAN SUGAR AND THE FINANCIAL CONSEQUENCES OF THEIR ELIMINATION IN RELATION TO THE ACCESSION OF BULGARIA AND ROMANIA:**

Paragraph 2 of Chapter 3 of Annex V to Act of Accession of Bulgaria and Romania provides that any stock of product, private as well as public, in free circulation at the date of accession within the territory of Bulgaria and Romania exceeding the quantity which could be regarded as constituting a normal carryover of stock must be eliminated at the expense of the new Member States. The draft decision fixes the surplus stock and the financial consequences as regards Romania.

Result of the vote: favorable opinion (281 votes in favor, 60 abstentions and 4 against)

**3. EXCHANGE OF VIEWS CONCERNING A REVIEW OF REGULATION (EC) NO 612/2009 AND 1301/2006:**

A preliminary exchange of views was held on the possible modifications of the said Regulations, based on the contributions of Member States.

**4. EXCHANGE OF VIEWS ON THE APPLICATION OF ARTICLE 17 OF REGULATION (EC) NO 612/2009:**

Some MS gave an oral presentation as to the role of operator's book keeping obligations in national legislation.

**5. UPDATE ON ISAMM:**

COM gave an overview on activities in MS in the production environment following the entry into force of Regulation (EC) No 557/2010 of 24.06.2010 (OJ L 159 of 25.06.2010) which provides that certain communications covered by this regulation are to be made obligatorily via ISAMM as from 01.07.2010.
