## **Short Report of the 99<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing Committee on Organic Farming (SCOF) of 7-8 July 2011**

**President: Mr Hulot**

25 Member States were present on the 7<sup>th</sup> and/or on the 8<sup>th</sup> of July 2011. Norway and Switzerland were present as observers.

### **Section A – Opinion of the Committee**

- 1. (possibly) Draft Commission Implementing Regulation amending Regulation (EC) No 1235/2008 laying down detailed rules for implementation of Council Regulation (EC) No 834/2007 as regards the arrangements for imports of organic products from third countries**

The draft Commission Implementing Regulation was not presented for the opinion of the Committee.

- 2. (possibly) Draft rules of procedure for the Standing Committee on Organic Farming, as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EU) No 182/2011 ("new Comitology")**

The draft rules of procedure were not presented for the opinion of the Committee.

### **Section B - Points for information and/or discussion**

#### **1. Organic legislation**

An exchange of views and discussion took place on the basis of working documents concerning organic wine and animal feed rules.

#### **2. Expert Group on Technical Advice for Organic Farming**

The state of play of the requests received by Member States was presented together with the outcome of the works of the sub-groups on feed and fertilisers as well as planned future activities.

### **3. Reporting and notifications under organic farming legislation**

The updated list of EU control authorities and control bodies was presented. Delegations were invited to provide comments by 15 July 2011 at the latest. An overview of other notifications according to the organic farming legislation was presented.

### **4. Import regime**

An overview of the situation concerning annual reports from Third Countries listed for equivalence as well as pending requests for recognition was presented. Information was also provided on the negotiations with Canada.

### **5. Codex Alimentarius**

The outcome of the meeting of the 39th session of the Codex Alimentarius Committee on Food Labelling on 9-13 May 2011 was presented together with information on future works.

### **6. Ecolabel**

The state of play of the Ecolabel for food and feed study was presented.

### **7. Irregularities and controls**

An update of notifications concerning EU irregularities as well as irregularities for imported to the EU products was presented.

### **8. Miscellaneous**

The Commission provided information concerning different questions raised by the delegations. Information was also provided concerning the report to the Council and the Parliament foreseen by Article 41 of Council Regulation (EC) No 834/2007.
