Description : AREA started out as a Heritage Laboratory on the archives of European archaeology in 1999 and then in AREA phase II financed last year by Culture 2000 they designed the database with over 3000 entries. This proposal represents the third stage of AREA in which special emphasis will be placed on stimulating archives-based research on the history of archaeology.
