Description: The grant is requested to put the focus on different modes of criticism in capitalist and socialist countries. The project examines the last 30 years and along with them changes in the perception of societies and space through social critique. The project deals with the visual arts and architecture/town planning, and is bundled around three focal points with regard to contents: - space and space distribution/spatial inclusions and exclusion mechanisms; - the influence of new media (film/TV) on town planning/urban perception and related concepts of identity; - participation and activation of subjects and community groups. The activities take place in art institutions, at university and in the public space. The format ranges from exhibitions and panel discussions to art in public space and scholarships. The project should stimulate a debate on the tool and power of critical articulation in each of the involved countries.

Objectives: - to investigate the criticism of Modernism in capitalist and socialist countries; - to redefine the relationship between Modernism and Postmodernism; - to gain a deeper understanding of the different approaches of the past 30 years; - it is planned to work out a common ground for upcoming critical discussions and debates and to ask what criticality could mean today. The project seeks to conduct an inquiry of what happened to these critical approaches from today's perspective etc.
