WHY DID WE DO THIS PROJECT?

- \Rightarrow Increased challenges in terms of professionalization in the Parasport Sector
- \Rightarrow Lack of cooperation and exploitation of *cross-boarder* projects
- \Rightarrow Varying knowledge and experience between different organisations and regions in Europe




