GENERAL OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRAMME

The Youth in Action Programme was the EU Programme for all young people. The Programme aimed to inspire a sense of active European citizenship and tolerance among young Europeans and to involve them in shaping the Union's future by boosting their participation in democratic life. It has promoted mobility, non-formal learning and intercultural dialogue among European youth, and encouraged the inclusion of all young people, particularly those with fewer opportunities, by supporting a large variety of activities, including youth exchanges, transnational voluntary service as well as training and networking for youth workers.

Duration:2007-2013Budget:EUR 885 million for seven yearsTarget group:15-28 years old (in some cases 13-30), youth workers and youth organisations





Number of projects per Action




- More than 12 100 projects granted
- Out of more than 25 700 projects submitted
- 51% of projects had the inclusion of young people with fewer opportunities as a priority
- Support to the operating costs of 90 European NGOs
- **Support to 35 National Agencies** (the bigger part of the Programme is managed by National Agencies, the rest is managed by the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency), 8 Resource Centers, 35 Eurodesk national partners



Projects submitted and granted per Action


2013: OVERVIEW IN TERMS OF PARTICIPANTS




Number of participants per Action

- Close to 275 000 participants
- More than 266 000 young people and youth workers have participated in decentralised projects involving mobility, of which 46% went abroad
- Turnover among beneficiaries: 62% of the 2013 beneficiaries were not beneficiaries in 2012
- 31% of the total number of young participants were young people with fewer opportunities
- Close to 11 700 participants from Neighbouring Partner Countries in decentralised projects: 43% from Eastern Europe and Caucasus, 37% from South East Europe and 20% from Mediterranean Countries
