The wireframe gives an overview of an exhibition editor that does not proceed in wizard steps, but rather provides all editing functions at all times. This type of editor might suit people with some experience in editing presentations, layouts etc. but might be too overwhelming for beginners. The suitability of the editor with the timeline template and other different types of templates need to be thought in more detail. The editor should also provide functions such as removing pages/media items etc. and an option to move content from one page to another.

De eerste bewoners van Almere

[Meer...](#)

Van oorsprong waren de **IJsselmeerpolders** vooral of zelfs uitsluitend bedoeld als landbouwgrond. Echter, na de **Tweede Wereldoorlog** kwam men tot het inzicht dat de snel groeiende bevolking van met name **Amsterdam** voor een deel elders gehuisvest zou moeten worden. Zo ontwierp men twee steden in de polders **Oostelijk** en **Zuidelijk Flevoland**. De stad in Oostelijk Flevoland werd **Lelystad**, de stad in zuidelijk Flevoland werd op de eerste schetsen nog *Zuidweststad* genoemd, maar kreeg in de **jaren zeventig** de naam *Almere*, naar de vroeg-middeleeuwse naam van de **Zuiderzee** (zie **Almere (meer)**).

De eerste woningen in Almere werden opgeleverd in **november 1976**.^[1] De stad werd toen nog direct bestuurd door het *Openbaar Lichaam Zuidelijke IJsselmeerpolders* (*Z.I.J.P.*), met een **landdrost** aan het hoofd. In **1984** werd wat er nog over was van het OL ZIJP opgedeeld in de gemeenten Almere en **Zeewolde**. De gemeente Almere beschouwt zich als de rechtsoptvolger van het Openbaar Lichaam en voert ook hetzelfde **wapen**. Tot 1986, de oprichting van de provincie Flevoland, nam het **Ministerie van Binnenlandse Zaken** de provincietaken waar.

Oorspronkelijk was Almere opgezet als meerkernige stad. Dit beleid is gedeeltelijk losgelaten. Almere Buiten en Almere Stad zijn via de wijk **Tussen de Vaarten** aan elkaar gegroeid. Tussen de oudste en de nieuwste woonwijken ziet men duidelijk een veranderd woningbouwbeleid terug: in de jaren zeventig was dit gericht op gelijkvormigheid en functionaliteit, in de **jaren negentig** werd het de trend meer exclusieve en opvallende woningen te bouwen, bijvoorbeeld in de **Regenboogbuurt**.

Het centrum van Almere Stad, het grootste stadsdeel, is sterk aan het uitbreiden. In 2006 is het eerste deel van het nieuw gebouwde stadscentrum opgeleverd. Het voornaamste gebouw hiervan is de Citadel, ontworpen door **Pritzker Prize**-winnaar **Christian de Portzamparc**. Begin 2007 zijn de nieuwe **Schouwburg Almere** en **Kunstencentrum de Kunstlinie** in gebruik genomen. Het opvallende pand, gelegen aan het Weerwater, is op 8 juni 2007 officieel

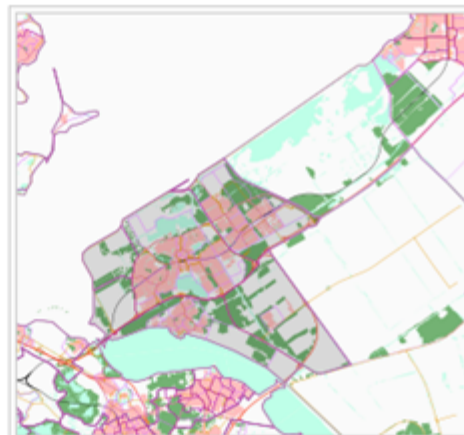

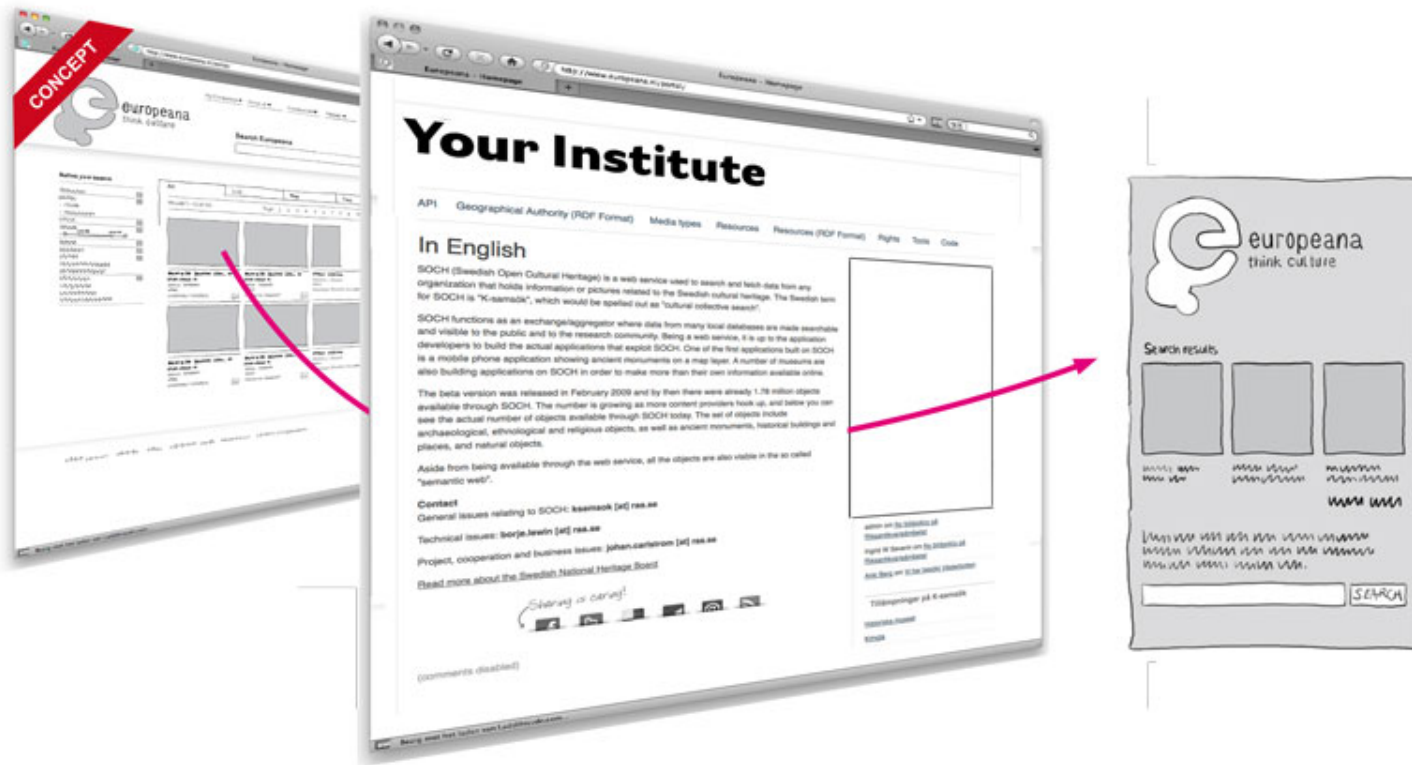

Presentation of a new multi-lingual Mediterranean television channel during the COPEAM conference

From 8 to 11 April 2010, the Permanent Conference of Mediterranean Audiovisual Operators (COPEAM), has met in Paris under the patronage of Mr Nicolas Sarkozy, President of the French Republic. Co-organised by Institut National de l'Audiovisuel (Ina) and supported by France's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Ministry of Culture and Communication, the 17th General Conference presented three flagship projects :

- The Channel for the Mediterranean: A multi-lingual and multi-cultural Mediterranean satellite television channel.
- MeD MeM: an Internet portal for the Mediterranean audiovisual heritage, supported by the Euromed heritage programme.
- The Mediterranean Audiovisual University: a network of universities and schools training in audiovisual media and cinema within the Mediterranean region.

700 attendees from all European Mediterranean countries made the conference successful. INA CEO, Emmanuel Hoog, was unanimously re-elected as COPEAM President for the next 2 years. A call was launched to support the creation of the multi-cultural, multi-lingual Mediterranean Channel that will broadcast in all countries around the Mediterranean, addressing over 770 millions inhabitants. Many countries will contribute and the programmes will combine North and South perspectives.
