On 27 September 2012, Siim Kallas, Vice-President of the EC in charge of Transport, gave a press conference to set out an ambitious package of proposals to boost the international competitiveness of the EU's aviation industry by opening negotiations with key partners to access new business opportunities in the fast growing markets, developing new tools to fight unfair competition and creating the right regulatory conditions to stimulate investment.
