Ministers were expected to agree a partial general approach on aligning the existing implementing powers enshrined in the four so-called breakfast-directives with the new rules on delegated acts as set out in the Treaty on the Functioning of the EU. The Council has taken stock of progress made on a draft decision aimed at strengthening EU capacities and structures for effectively responding to serious cross-border health threats. The Council was also due to adopt conclusions on: · organ donation and transplantation; · healthy ageing across the lifecycle. During lunch, ministers will had a discussion on the implementation of the joint action plan on medical devices following the PIP crisis.
