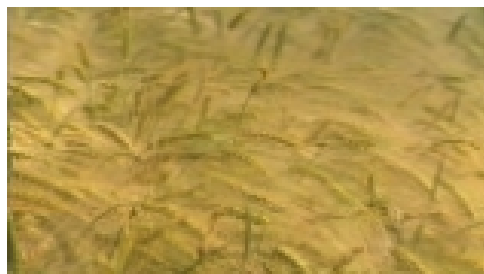


## EU: First Certification Schemes for Biofuels
