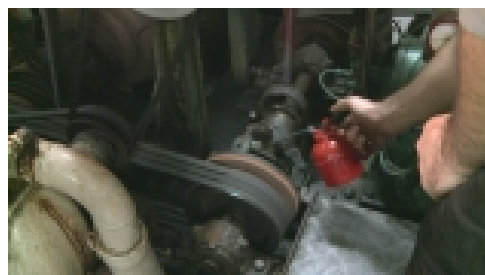

This video stockshot on fisheries in the Mediterranean Sea includes footage of the following:- Fishermen's lives - Greece and Italy;- Fishing ports - Cyprus, Greece, Italy and Spain;- Aquaculture - Cyprus and Greece;- Fish Auctions and Markets - Cyprus, Greece, Italy and Spain;- Fish restaurants - Cyprus and Spain;- Ancillary activities - Greece and Spain.Europe is surrounded by oceans and seas. The EU has some 70 000 km of coastline. Almost half of all EU citizens live within 50 km of the sea and almost 40% of the EU's GDP is generated in the maritime regions. Fisheries in the Mediterranean Sea are mostly characterised by small scale vessels (less than 12 m), carrying out multi-species and multi-gear activities, as well as by the multiplicity of landing points. As the majority of its waters fall under international jurisdiction, cooperation is important among both EU and non-EU coastal countries.

In terms of processing, Sicily has the largest number of companies dealing with fish conservation in Italy (32%), and the highest number of jobs in this field (27%).The Sicilian fishing fleet currently comprises 3323 vessels and represents by far the largest regional fleet in Italy.Most of the boats use set longlines, purse seines and bottom otter trawls. 55% of the gross tonnage of the Sicilian fleet are specialized vessels and includes mainly bottom otter trawlers and set gill-nets.	00:00:18

	<p>for their usual 6 days fishing-campaign in the Strait of Sicily and off the Cap Bon, in Tunisia. More than 60% of Sicilian catches are fished in GSA 16, the Strait of Sicily (Canale di Sicilia), a 145 km wide channel that divides the Tyrrhenian Sea and the western Mediterranean Sea from the eastern Mediterranean. Mazàra hosts the most recent fleet, with 30% of all Sicily new vessels built in 2010. But in the same period, between November 2010 and November 2011, 20 vessels were scrapped under EU funded programmes for fishing vessels demolition.</p>

It plays an important role in preserving the economic and social well-being of many coastal and island communities. Sea Fisheries: In 2011 the Greek professional fishing fleet, according to the European Union Fishing Fleet Register, consisted of 16,696 vessels. Hellenic fishing vessels are not part of an industrialized fleet. The vast majority of them are characteristic of small-scale fishery. Important fishing shelters are Larnaca, Latchi, Paralimni and Peyia.The Inshore Fishery is practiced with small wooden boats of 6 to 12 m length overall (O.A.L), which mainly fish with bottom set nets and long lines (passive gears) and fish traps. In 2003, 677 persons were occupied as full time fishermen in 500 licensed boats. The Trawl Fishery (mobile gears) consists of 22 bottom fishing trawlers.The polyvalent vessels fish with nets and bottom long lines but periodically also with surface long lines, fishing for swordfish/tuna. The main species of marine fish cultured/fattened on a commercial basis are Sparus aurata (gilthead seabream), Decentrarchus labrax (seabass) and Thunnus thynnus (bluefin tuna).Aquaculture accounts, in terms of volume, for approximately 70% of Cyprus fisheries production, while in terms of value, it exceeds 70%. Aquaculture in Greece provides a significant contribution to primary sector production.
