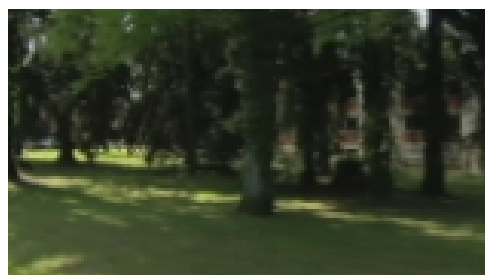




Inauguration of the JRC visitors center in Ispra with the participation of Máire Geoghegan-Quinn
