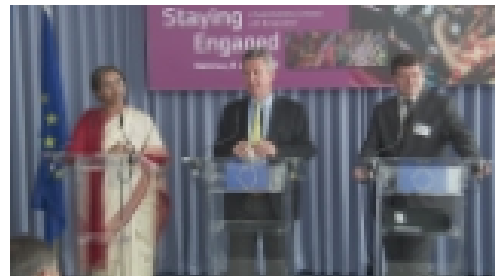


## Statement by Karel De Gucht on the start of Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership negotiations
