On 16 October 2013, Štefan Füle, Member of the EC in charge of Enlargement and European Neighbourhood Policy, gave a press conference to present the 2014 Enlargement Package. The EC recommended granting EU candidate status to Albania and, for the fifth time in a row, the opening of accession negotiations with the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. The Commission also assessed the progress towards EU accession made elsewhere in the Western Balkans over the past year.
