

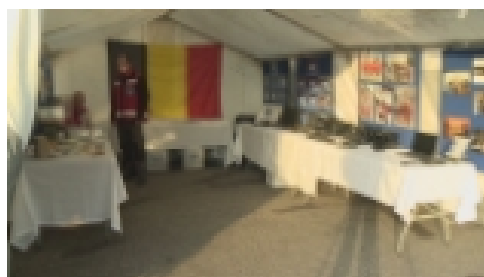

And I'm proud that it was a European team, a Belgian team that was the first to provide medical services in clean water to the population of Tacloban virtually three days after the disaster hit.</p>	00:00:44
