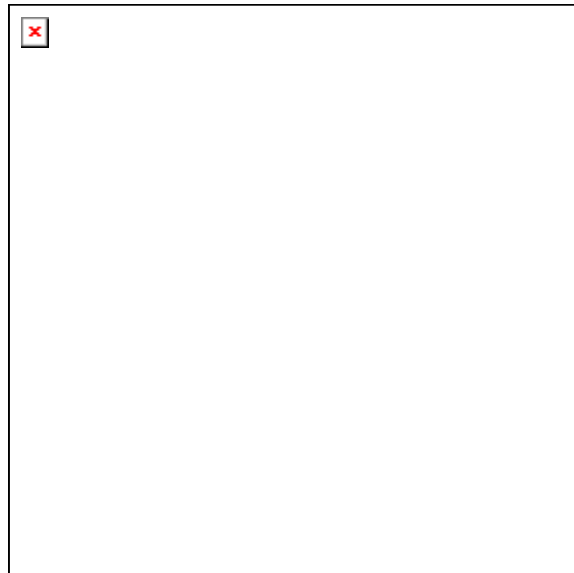

There will be two panel debates on the following topics:

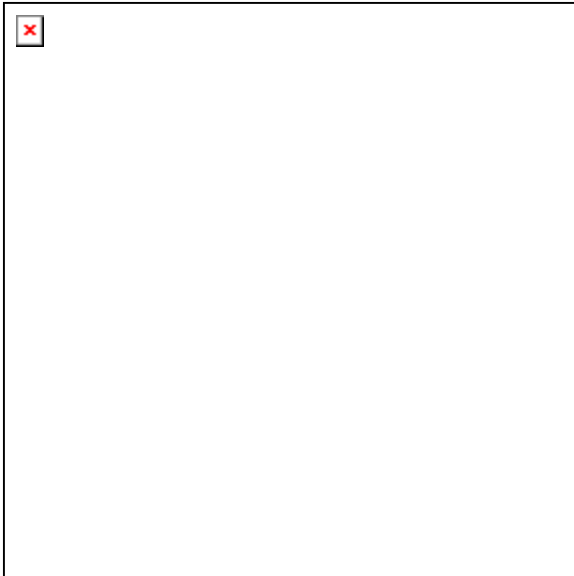
- *The geopolitics of energy: Can Europe safeguard viable and stable access to resources?*
