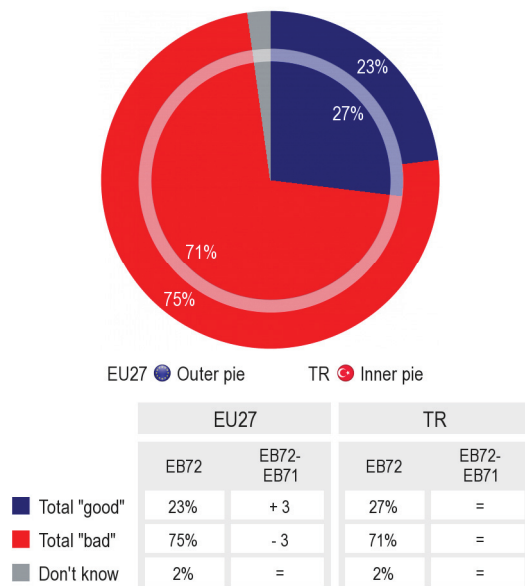

QA2.1. How would you judge the current situation in each of the following?

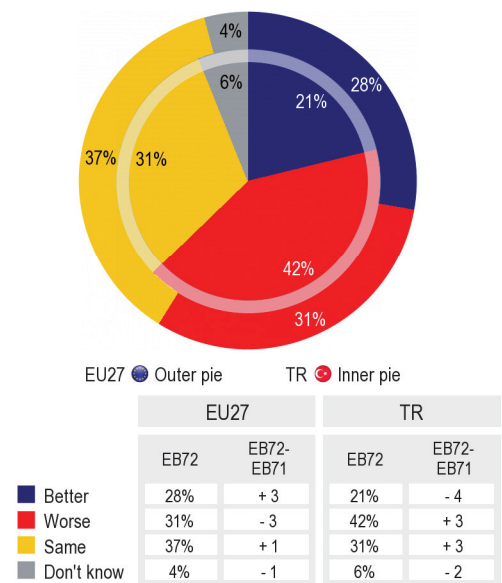
The situation of the (NATIONALITY) economy

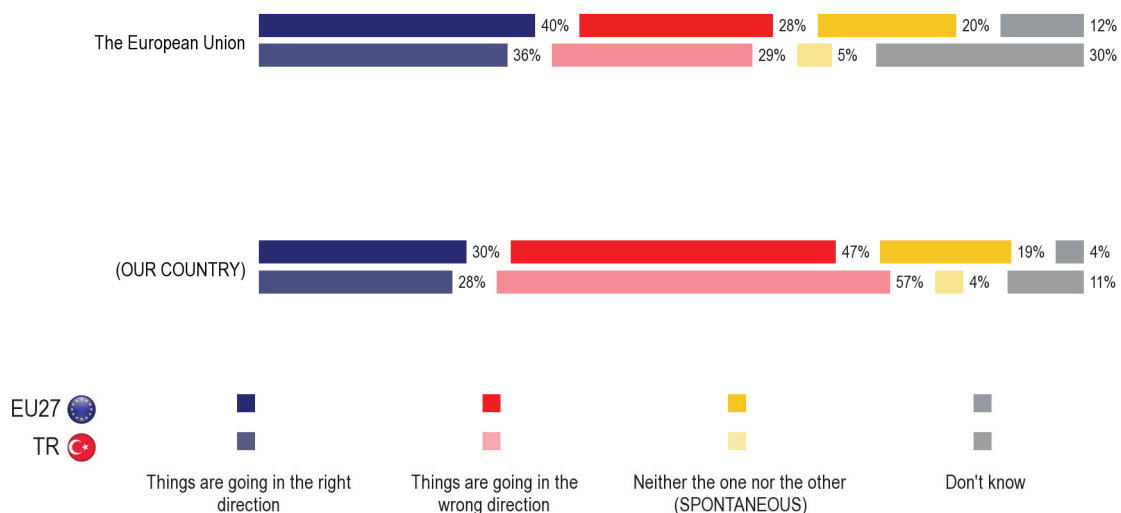
QA4.2. What are your expectations for the next 12 months: will the next 12 months be better, worse or the same, when it comes to...?

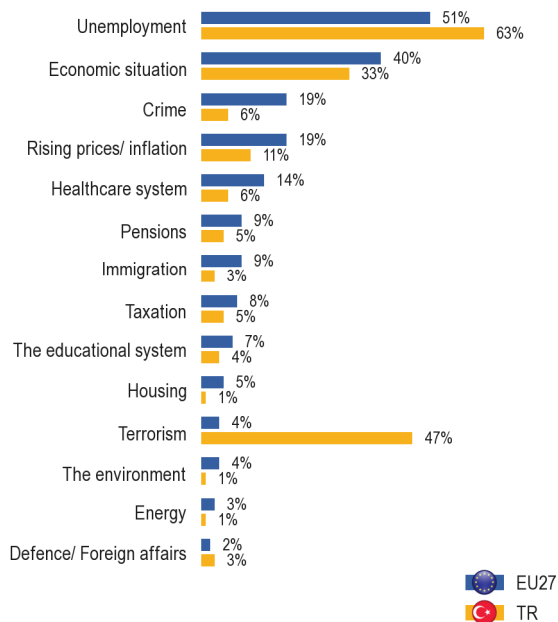
QA9. At the present time, would you say that, in general, things are going in the right direction or in the wrong direction, in...?

QA5. What do you think are the two most important issues facing (OUR COUNTRY) at the moment?



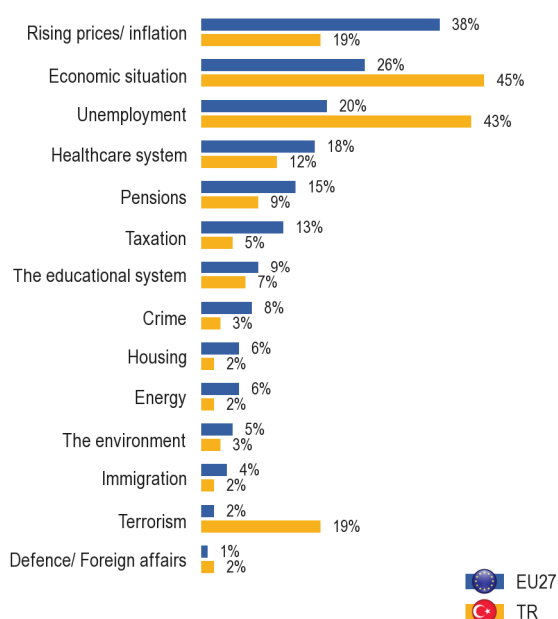

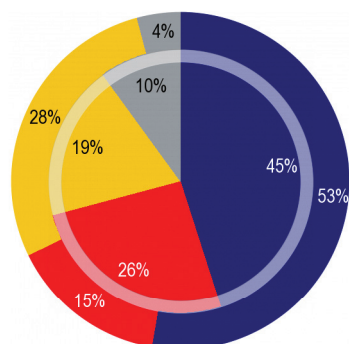

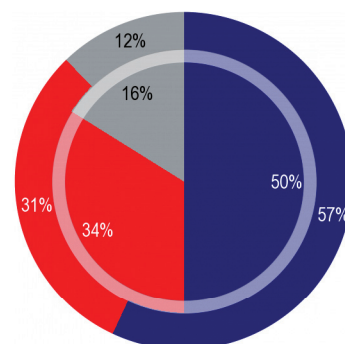

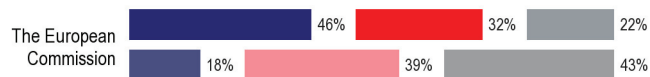

QA18ab. On the whole, are you very satisfied, fairly satisfied, not very satisfied or not at all satisfied with the way democracy works...

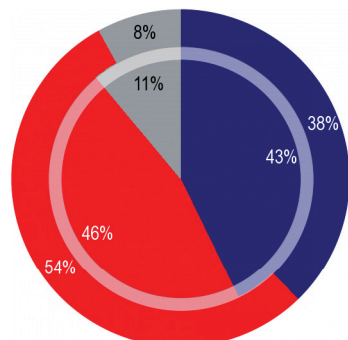

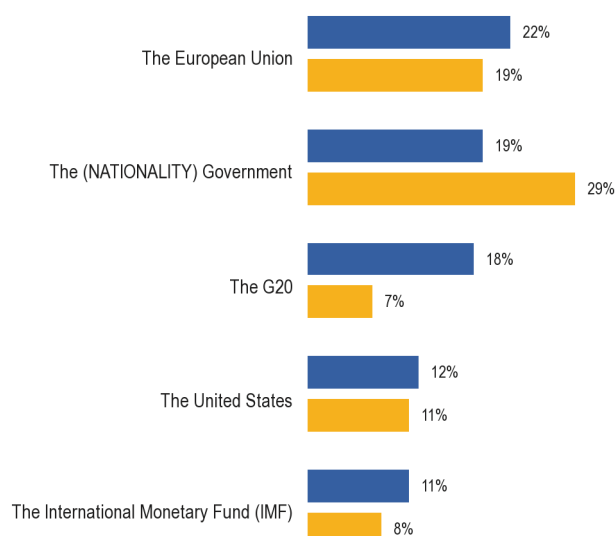
