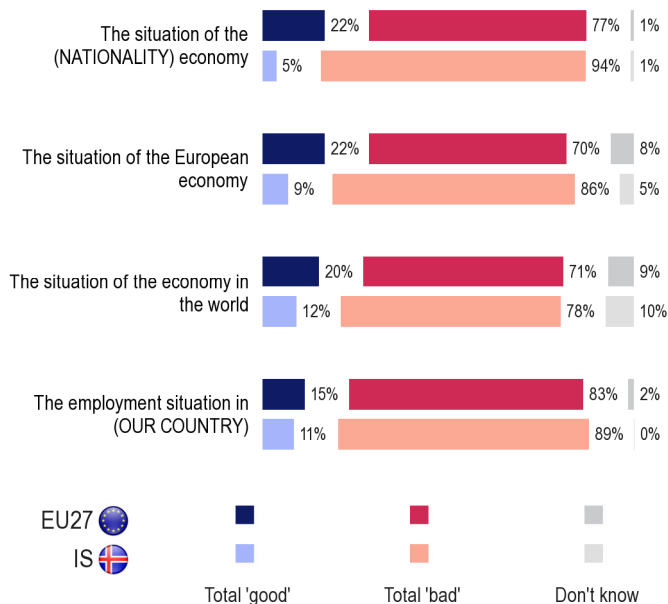
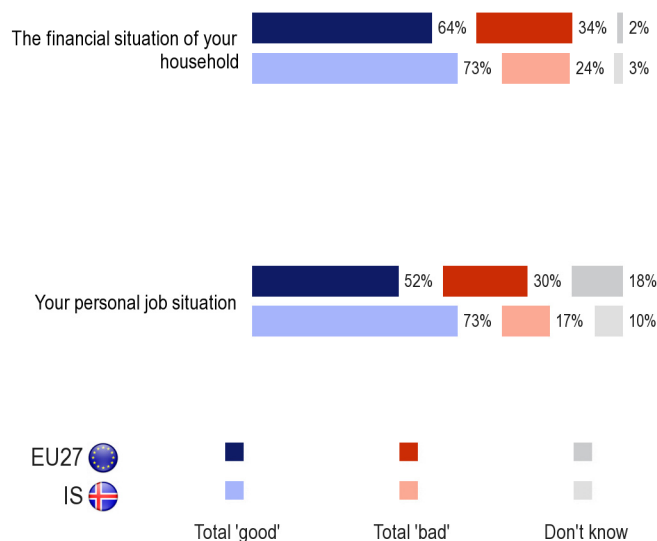

QA4. How would you judge the current situation in each of the following?



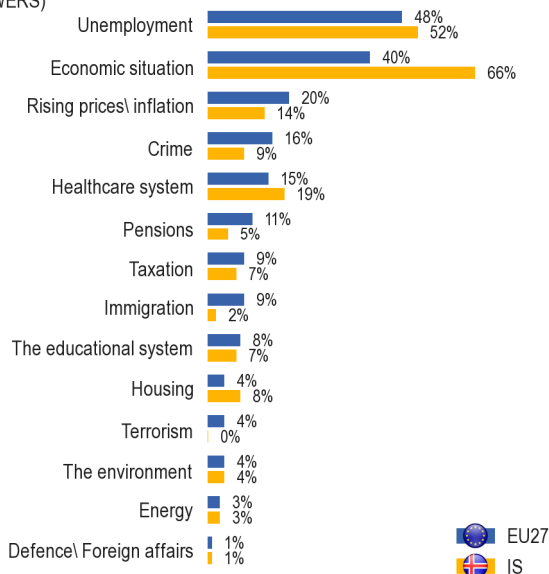

QA7. What do you think are the two most important issues facing (OUR COUNTRY) at the moment?

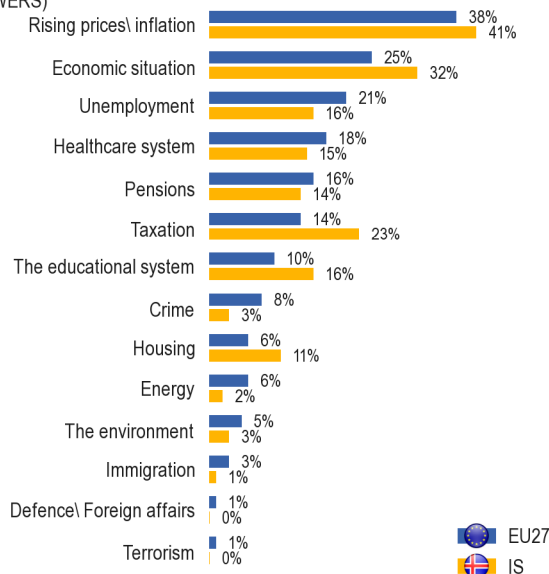

Main personal concerns

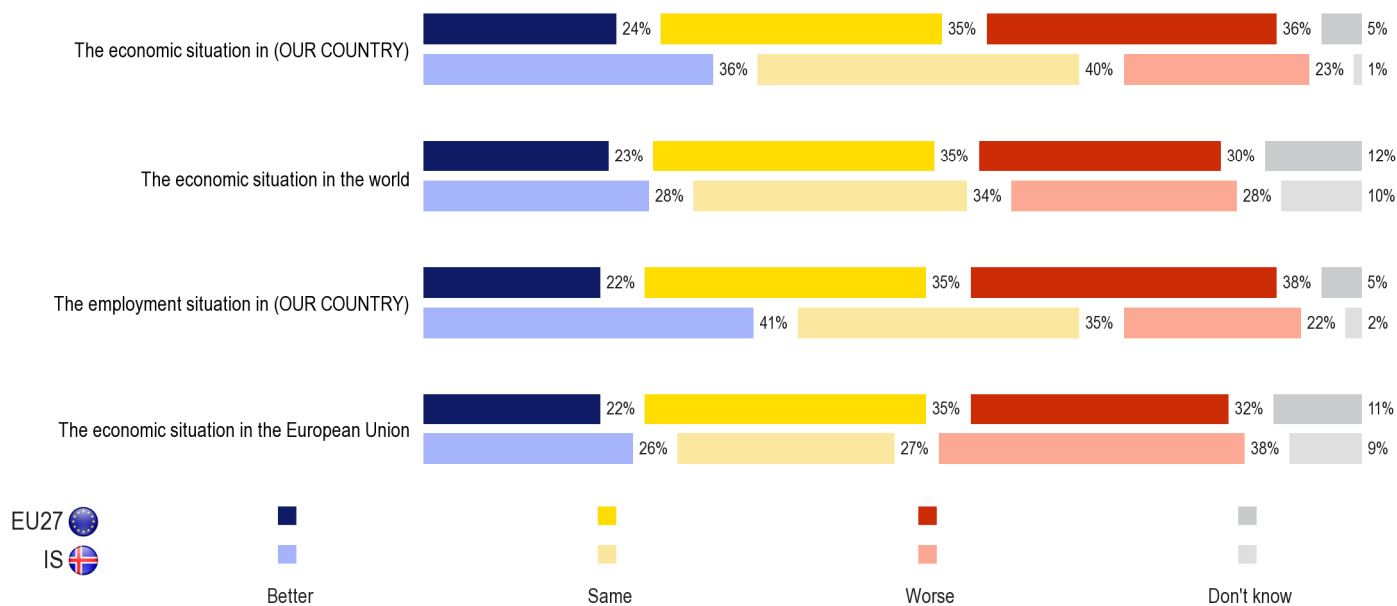

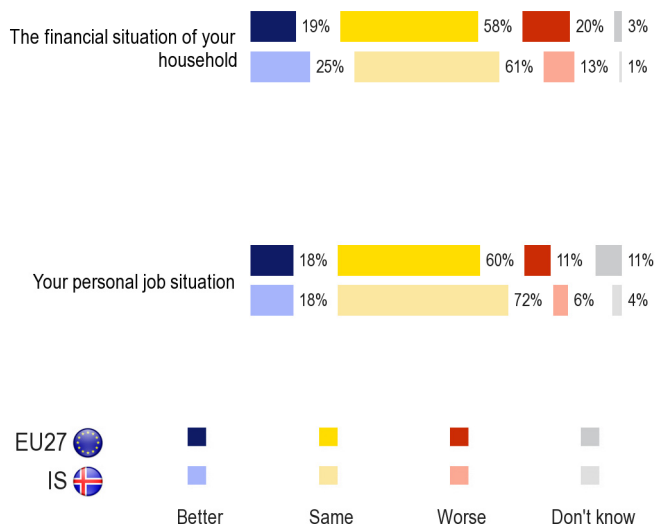

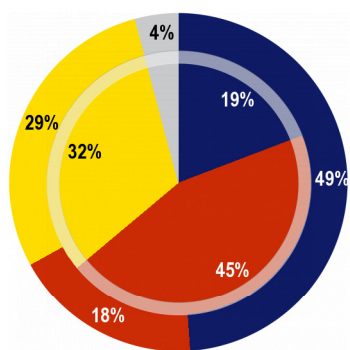

QA9. Generally speaking, do you think that (OUR COUNTRY)'s membership of the European Union would be...?*



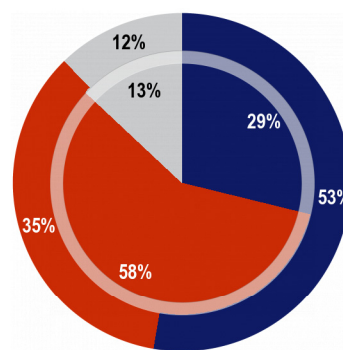

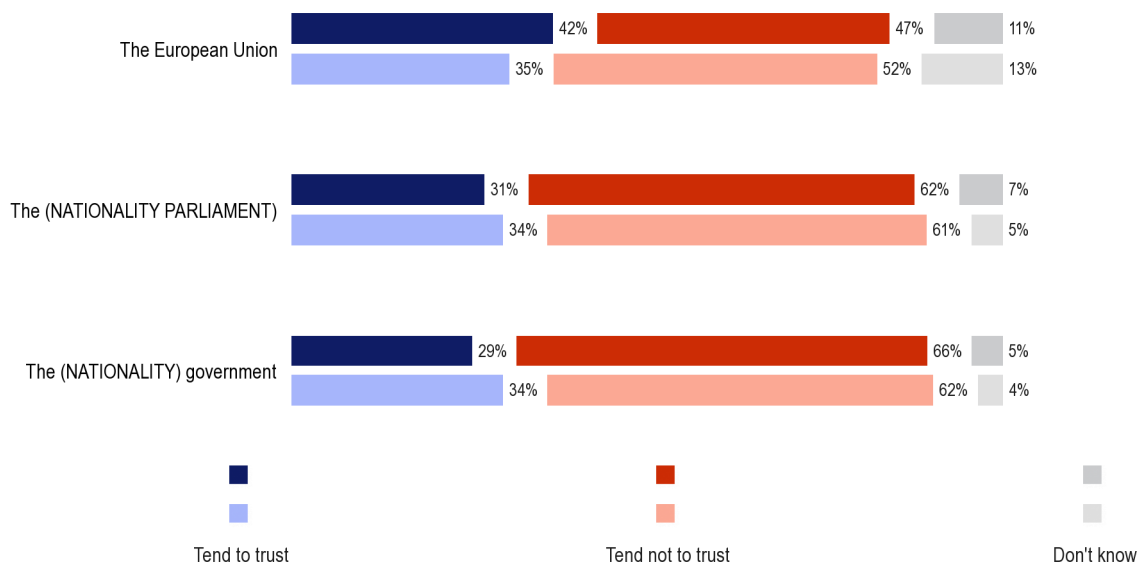

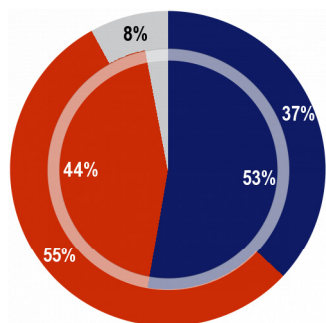

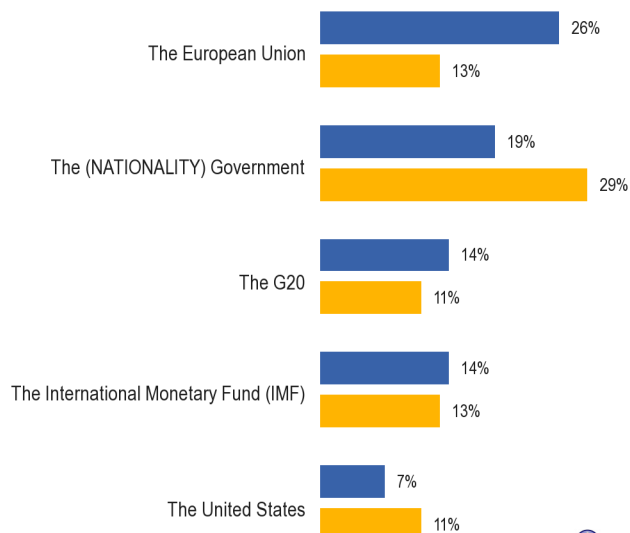

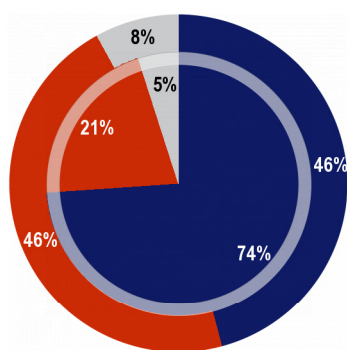

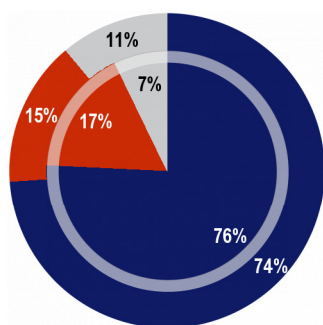

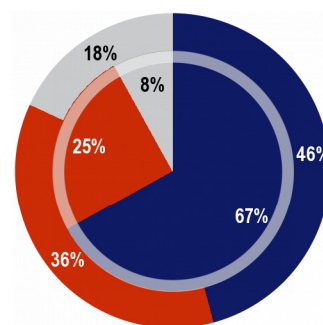

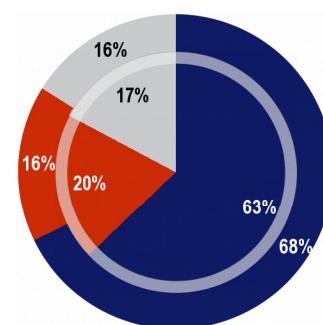

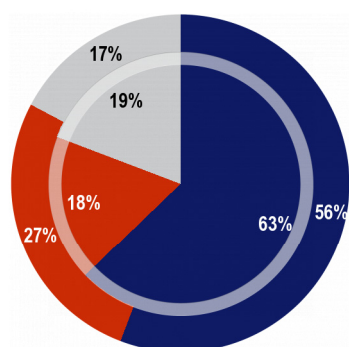
