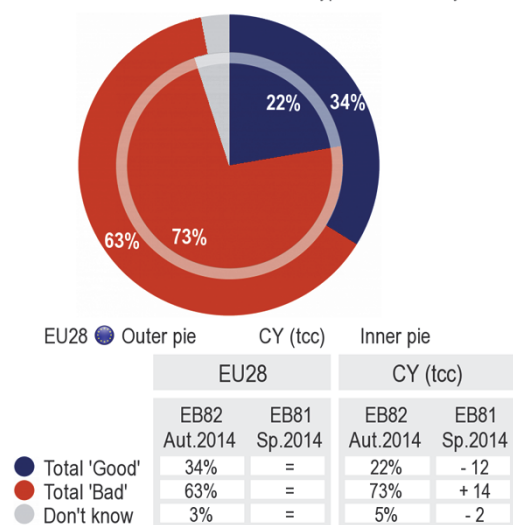

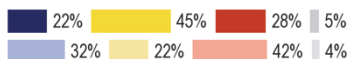

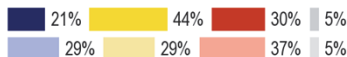

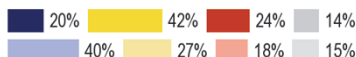
The economic situation in the Turkish Cypriot Community*



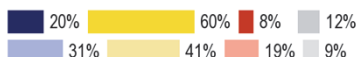
The employment situation in the Turkish Cypriot Community**

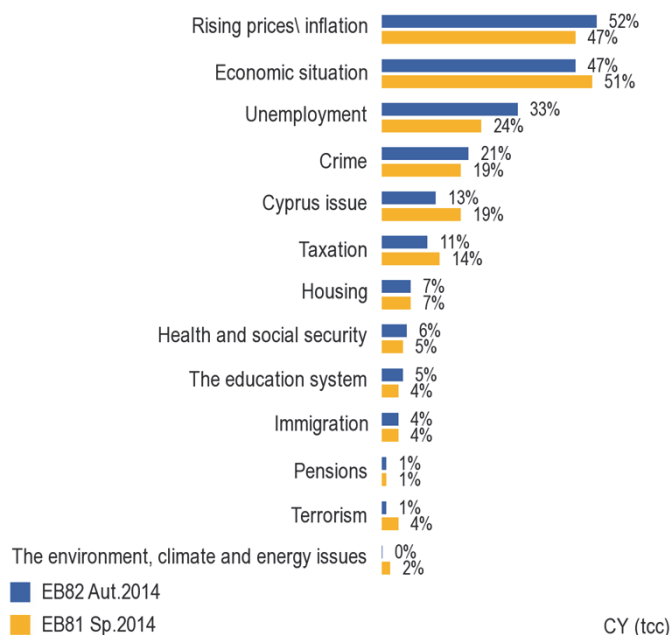

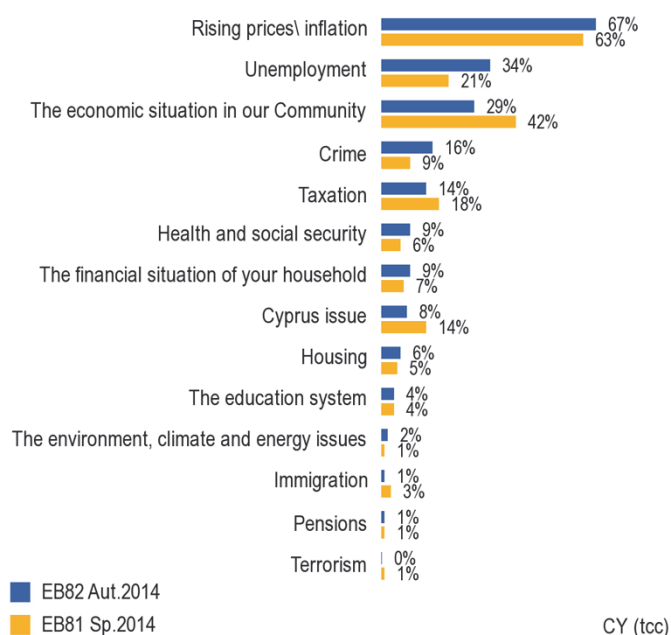

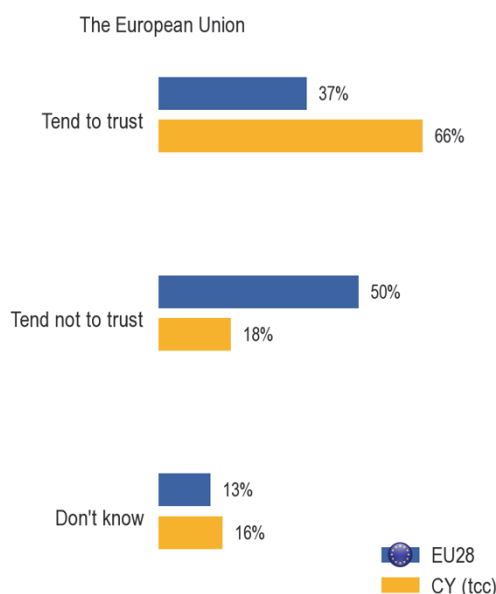
QA3b. What do you think are the two most important issues facing our Community at the moment?

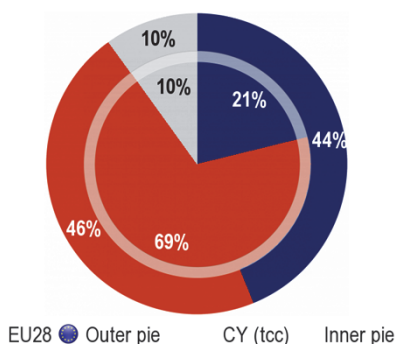

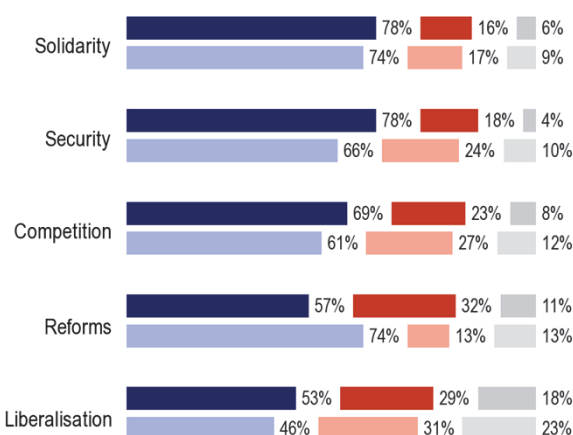

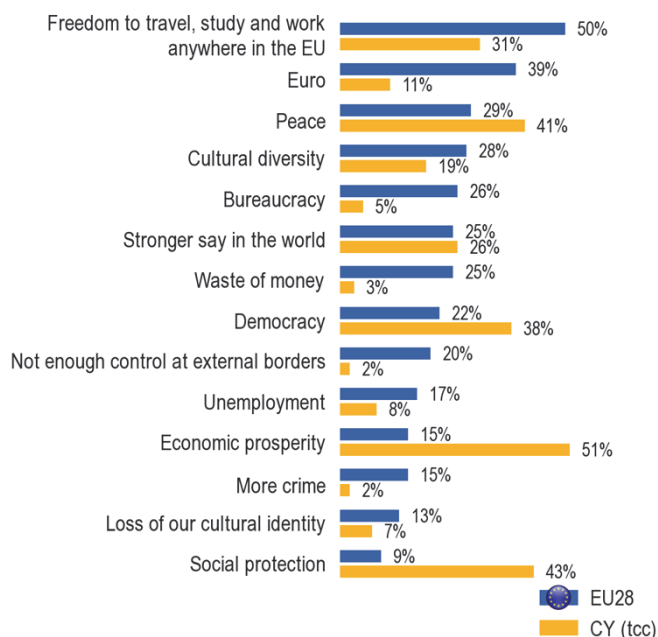

QA13. What does the EU mean to you personally?

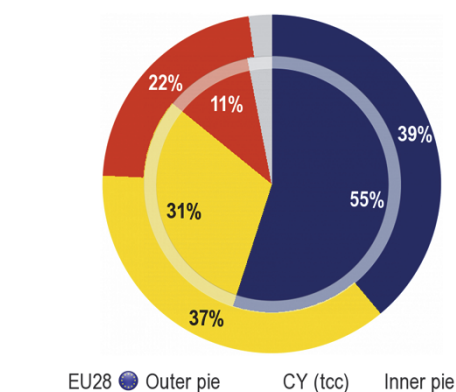
