- A draft of the Final Report is provided to the Advisory Committee, so as to allow it to take the Hearing Officer's views into account in its assessment of the case.
- After the Advisory Committee the Hearing Officer's Report will be finalized and submitted, together with the draft Decision, to the College of Commissioners to ensure that, when it reaches a decision on the case, it has been fully appraised of all relevant information as regards the course of the procedure and the procedural rights of all parties to the proceedings. The Hearing Officer may amend the Final Report in the light of any amendments to the draft Decision up to the time the Decision is adopted by the Commission.
- Subsequently, the Final Report is sent to the addressees together with the Commission's Passisian Commission's Decision.
