- 1. On 04/03/2008, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 by which Autogrill S.p.A. ("Autogrill", Italy) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1) (b) of this Regulation control of the whole of Aldeasa S.A. ("Aldeasa", Spain) by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - Autogrill: food and beverage and retail services for travelers worldwide
 - Aldeasa: operation of travel retail shops in Spain and Portugal, and outside the EU.
- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 and of paragraph 5, subparagraph d of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004².
