The member of the consultative entity is appointed:

1) as representative of a public authority (national, regional or local), of civil society or as interested party. The member is appointed by the Commission or its departments. Where the composition of the group is likely to vary, in particular, the authorities or organisations concerned may nominate the expert to represent them. Indicator: full title and, where feasible, URL address.

2) in a personal capacity. The member is appointed by the Commission or its departments and shall act completely independently.

<sup>3</sup> *Travel, and where appropriate, subsistence expenses incurred by member, experts and observers as part of the activities of the group shall normally be reimbursed by the Commission. Where reimbursement takes place, it shall be in accordance with the provisions in force within the Commission and within the limits of the available appropriations allocated to the Commission department concerned under the annual procedure for the allocation of resources. The tasks carried out shall not be subjected to remuneration. Payment of a special allowance to members, experts and observers shall only be possible in duly justified and exceptional cases and*
