



Annette BORCHSENIUS

Mrs. Annette Borchsenius graduated from Copenhagen University as Master of Law, and from the INSEAD in Paris as International Business Executive.

Mrs. Borchsenius has since 2007 been Head of Division in the Danish Ministry for Science, Technology and Higher Education. She is responsible for the Danish participation in European research projects under the European Framework programmes. She is Head of the Danish organisation of National Contact Points on FP7 and works with advising researchers and companies. Further she is responsible for The Danish Agency for Science and Innovation's training programmes for potential framework programme participants. At the same time she contributes to formulating the Danish position on Horizon 2020 and to preparing the Danish Presidency to the EU Council in 2012.

She started her career in 1985 in the Danish Ministry for Industry where she worked with legal matters and international conventions under IMO and ILO as well as EU-directives and the OECD.

From 1994 to 1998 she worked in the Danish Bar and Law Society as Secretary of the Board and Advisor to the Secretary General. In addition, she was responsible for a number of committees on Business Law and for the Danish Bar and Law Society's participation in international organisations.

In 1998 Mrs. Borchsenius became Director of EuroCenter – an organisation under the Danish Ministry for Industry. EuroCenter provides advice and consultancy services on all issues regarding the internal market, technology transfer and innovation, European funding for research and transnational cooperation as well as researchers mobility. In this capacity she was Manager of the Danish EuroInfoCenter, the Innovation Relay Center as well as the Researchers Mobility Assistance Centre in Denmark.

Mrs. Borchsenius has been coordinator of several EU-projects and partner in a large number of EU-projects.
