



Ammar MIRAŠČIJA

Ammar Miraščija graduated in 1994 from Sarajevo University's Department of Philosophy and Sociology. Thereafter he followed further specialisation studies which took him to the UK, Hungary, Italy, and the USA. He received his MA from the Centre for Interdisciplinary Post Graduate Studies of Sarajevo University in 2004 having successfully defended his thesis on European Identity.

Mr. Miraščija was appointed to his current position as Head of Department for Science in the Ministry of Civil Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina in 2008. Prior to this, he was Director of the National Contact Point for EU Framework Programmes in Bosnia and Herzegovina (2004-2008). Since 2004 Ammar Miraščija is the National Coordinator for FP7 in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

He has previously worked as a coordinator for the Higher Education Fund at the Project Coordination Unit of the Bosnian Federal Ministry of Education and Science on the implementation of a World Bank funded project (2000-2004). He has also worked with the SOROS FOUNDATIONS, Open Society Fund Bosnia-Herzegovina, first as a Secretary General, and then as a Higher Education Programmes and Scholarships Coordinator (1994-2000).

Ammar Miraščija's primary areas of expertise are: Higher Education, International Cooperation in the field of Education, Science and RTD, EU Integrations (pre-accession funds, CARDS and IPA Programming), Relationships with multilateral organisations (EU and World Bank).
