

Sustainable economic and social development of Europe can not be made without regard to the preservation of natural and cultural heritage of European Union countries.

Otherwise, if even the most valuable core in terms of natural heritage, yet remained less affected by human activities will not acquire strict protection status, vain talk of sustainable development.
