approving the Opinion on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the European Council, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions

A modern budget for a Union that protects, empowers and defends the Multiannual Financial

Framework for the period 2021-2027

COM (2018) 321

pursuant to Articles 67 and 148 of the Romanian Constitution, republished, of Law No 373/2013 on cooperation between Parliament and the Government in the area of European affairs, 160-185 of the Rules of the Chamber of Deputies, approved by the Chamber of Deputies No 8/1994, republished, as amended,

The **Chamber of Deputies** hereby adopts this Decision.

Sole Article— Taking into account the opinion No 4c-19/297, adopted by the Committee for European Affairs at its meeting of 12 June 2018, the Chamber of Deputies:

1. Stresses the need for realisation positive agenda proposed by the European Commission and agreed by the leaders of the EU and its reflection in the future multiannual financial framework.

2. Recommends that the allocation of financial resources for combating youth unemployment initiatives with a high degree of innovation and creativity, and also to support training of a European environmental education, favourable investment and tax free initiative, entrepreneurship training and exercise its right on an enhanced EU and connected to the global market.

3. Stresses the need to make greater efforts to eliminate excessive practices in the management of EU funds, especially in the case of small and medium enterprises and those concerned in rural areas, simplification and flexibility for transfers between programmes, considering that the speed of their use and efficiency of spending of the Union budget should be as much in line with practices and return on investment and business projects, but to respond and the need to support small-scale investments.

4. Supports making tools, the Union budget, for young people and small businesses to take full advantage of the opportunities offered by the single market and digital economy.

5. Underlines the relevance of research and recommends that funds are available and scientific research, small and very small, especially innovative and potentially disruptive.

6. Draws attention to the need to ensure flexibility of performance indicators, so that they do not become a burden and a disincentive for development projects and for private investment, especially in economic conditions of unpredictability.

7. Supports the development of faster and wider as a new European Innovation Council, which will be a real one-stop shop for large and potentially disruptive innovators.

8. Supports the importance of the Creative Europe programme, the MEDIA sub-programme.

9. Recommends the establishment of a separate programme, devoted to energy efficiency and clean energy, in order to ensure both the horizontal nature of this thematic concentration, and already enshrined for LIFE Environment and Climate Action, its objectives of nature protection.

10. Recommends that the new structure proposed for external action instruments of the European Union include multiple ways to support trade relations between the Union and the African, Caribbean and Pacific States.

11. Recommends increasing the knowledge of regional specificity analysis for areas covered by the objectives of the strengthening and diversification of external trade relations as strong relations.

12. expresses its reservation on the European Commission's intention to reduce funding of traditional policies of the Union in agriculture and in increasing the cohesion, in particular in the light of the need to ensure a greater institutional participation in the decision-making process at Union level.

13. expresses its reservation on new own resources proposed, represented by the rate of 3 % applied to the new common consolidated tax base of companies.

14. you expressed a reservation on the proposal to increase national co-finanțării, in line with the decrease in pre-financing, in as it could have a major impact on the state budget.

15. Recommends that stronger attracting young and small and medium-sized enterprises in the European space programme, as strong diversification of organisations involved and increasing the educational dimension of the programme, opening in particular educational activity undertaken by the European Space Agency and the inclusion of such educational function, with direct participation of final beneficiaries, as many European agencies.
