# Second programme of Community action in the field of health (2008-13)

## Article 152 of the Treaty:

Incentive measure designed to protect and improve human health, 'excluding any harmonisation of the laws and regulations of the MS'.

1993-2002	<b>Eight separate action programmes</b>
2003-2008 €312 million	<b>Programme of Community action in the field of public health (2003-08)</b> Decision No 1786/2002/EC
2008-2013 €321.5 million	<b>Second programme of Community action in the field of health (2008-13)</b> Decision No 1350/2007/EC

# The Health Programme ...

- ... is the European Commission's main instrument for implementing the **EU health strategy**.
- ... aims to **improve the level of physical and mental health and well-being** of EU citizens and **reduce health inequalities** throughout the Community.
- ... supports **health-promoting and preventive actions** that address the major health determinants e.g., nutrition, physical activity, or smoking.
- ... is implemented in the form of **annual work plans**, which the European Commission adopts.

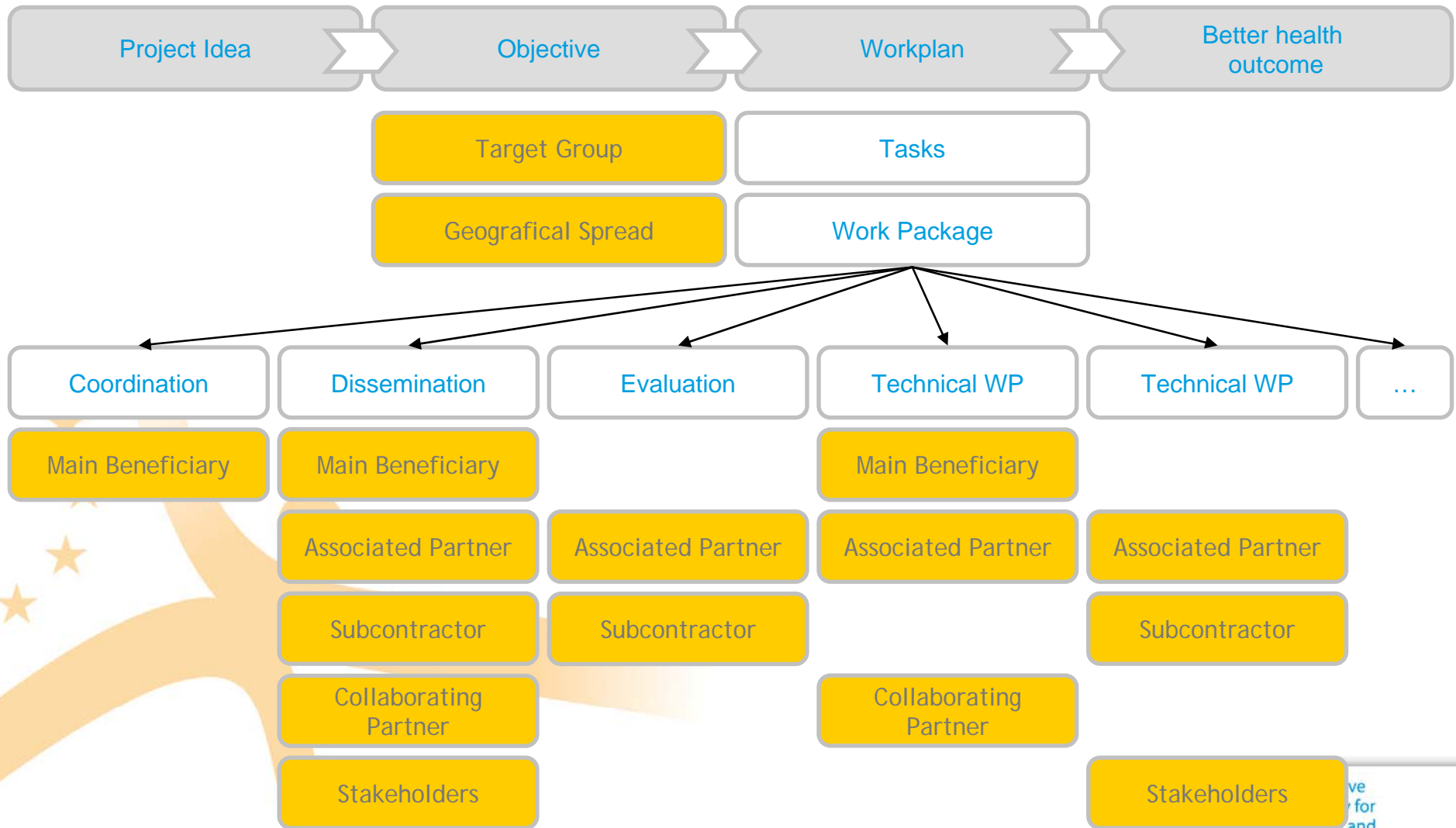

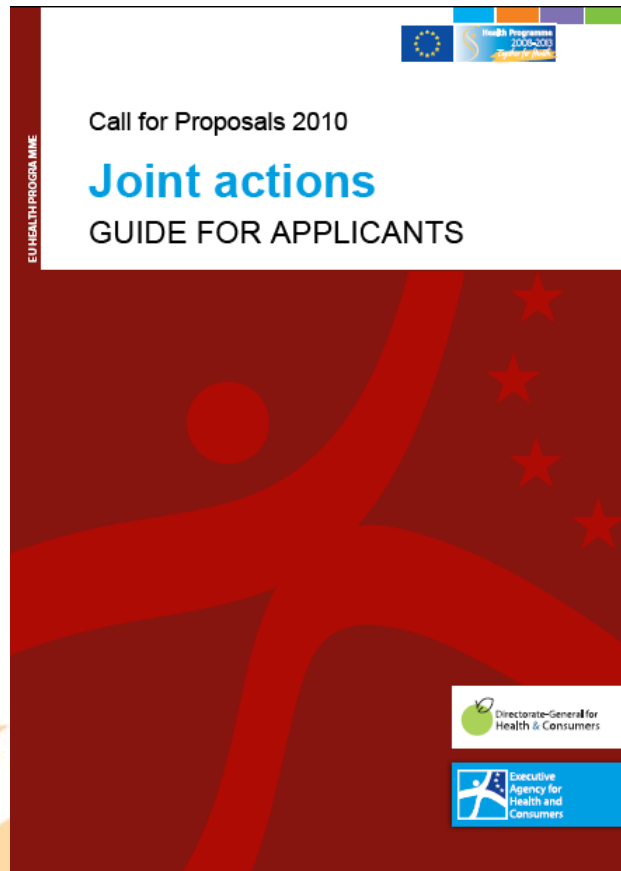

# Joint Actions



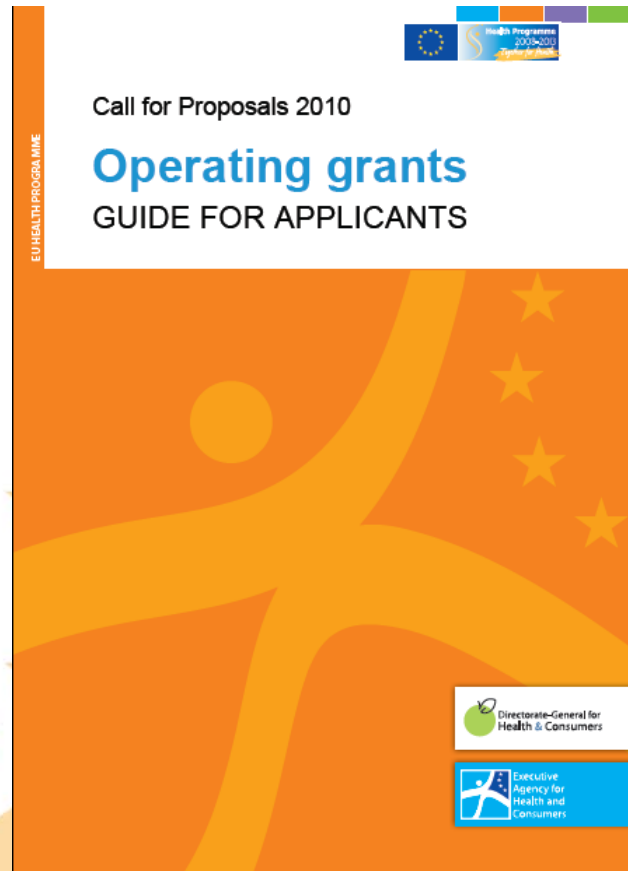
... are activities carried out by the **Community** and one or more **Member States** or by the Community and the **competent authorities** of other countries participating in the Programme together.

The authorities from countries participating in the second Health Programme will be **invited** to present proposals for joint actions i.e. this is not an open call.

The **priority areas** eligible for financing as joint actions in 2010 are specified in the 2010 Work Plan.

Community contribution may only be awarded to a **public body or a non-profit-making body** designated through a transparent procedure by the **Member State or the competent authority** concerned and **agreed by the Commission**.

# Operating Grants

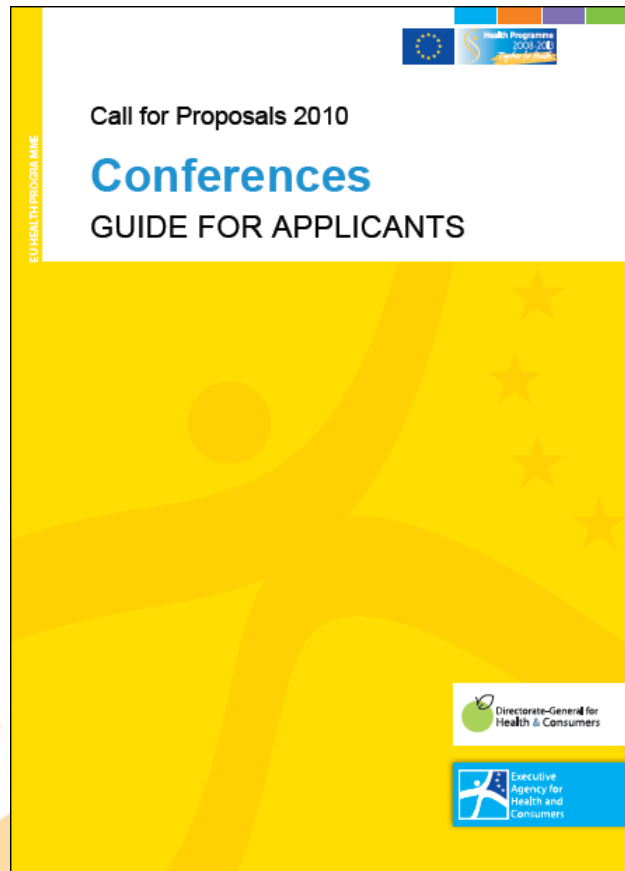


Non-governmental bodies or specialised networks from any of the eligible countries can submit an application for an operating grant.

A specialised network is a European network representing **non-profit bodies** active in the Member States or in countries participating in the second Health Programme and ...

- promoting principles and policies **consistent with the objectives of the Programme,**
- which has a **relevant track record** of joint achievements and
- **established rules of collaboration** (e.g. SOPs or a memorandum of understanding).

# Conferences



Chapter 3 of the 2010 Work Plan sets out details of the priority areas for action in implementing the programme. Proposals for conferences are eligible if **addressing once or more of those priorities**, even if a different financing mechanism is mentioned.

For administrative reasons, all conferences eligible for co-funding must be **held in 2011**.

Applicants should ensure that the conferences **build on and contribute to the dissemination of the results of other actions** of the current health programme and, where appropriate, of the previous public health programme or other relevant Union funding programmes.

# Call for tenders

- The aim of tender is to **purchase** the provision of services or the execution of works.
- The Work Plan for 2010 foresees a **significant number of calls for tenders** for the provision of services, in particular **preparation of studies, surveys and analyses** concerning various areas of public health.
- Calls for tenders will be **launched in the first half of 2010.**
- Please **consult the workplan 2010** for the priority areas under which calls for tender will be launched.

# Notice published with the Calls



# Call for proposals 2010

Ensure that the limited funding available at EU level will be focused on strategic topics and activities with an obvious European added value:

- **a balanced participation**
- **a more comprehensive and long-term approach creating synergy with past and current efforts funded under EU and national programmes**
- **including a full, independent evaluation**
- **a professional and effective dissemination of results to relevant target groups**
- **arrangements facilitating an effective uptake of new public health approaches by relevant decision makers**

Without prejudice to the criteria laid down in the work plan 2010, such proposals will be particularly welcome and not be penalised for a higher than average budget if this is warranted by the scope of activities.

# Consequences

- The selection procedure will be highly competitive in 2010.
- Only proposals which are excellent in all award criteria will have a chance to be funded.

## Negotiations - deadline

- Proposals that will be accepted under the call 2010 must finish contract negotiations by 31 December 2010.
- Negotiation not finished by that date will be terminated.

# Calls for proposals 2010

- Opened for projects, Joint Actions, conferences and operating grants on 22 Dec 2009
- Deadline for all proposals is **19 March 2010**
- Results not before 31 July 2010
- Negotiations to be finalized by 31 December 2010

# Mandatory checklist



# Mandatory checklist

- At the end of each application form
- Print with the application form, when finalized
- Fill the checklist by hand, date and sign – proposal manager, not legal representative (unlike Declaration of Honour)
- If checklist or any other mandatory document is missing – immediate rejection of the proposal

**Be aware that only complete application packages will be admitted to the evaluation procedure.**

**Applicants are responsible to ensure the application is complete according to the requirements specified in the call.**

**Incomplete application packages will be automatically excluded.**

# What's new - projects



## Project proposals – look as what is asked for

Only project proposals which directly correspond to the specific topics described in sections 3.2, 3.3 and 3.4 and where **'call for proposals for projects'** is indicated as the financing mechanism will be considered for funding.

Proposals which only address the wider subject area without matching the specific description of a given topic **will not be considered** for funding.

# Project proposals – look as what is asked for - example

- 3.2.1 - ***PROTECT CITIZENS AGAINST HEALTH THREATS***
- 3.2.1.1 - **Develop prevention and control of existing or emerging communicable diseases**
- (no number) **Improve control of communicable diseases**
- (no number) « - » Setting up a tool kit for immunisation registries, indicating ways of cooperation with ECDC, and examining the conditions of its transfer, adaptation and use in Member States. The aim is to improve national, regional and local reporting systems on issues related to immunisation using a common tool and thereby facilitate comparison between Member States' immunisation coverage.

# Project proposals – look as what is asked for - example

- **3.3.2 - PROMOTE HEALTHIER WAYS OF LIFE AND REDUCE MAJOR DISEASES AND INJURIES BY TACKLING HEALTH DETERMINANTS**

- **3.3.2.2. - Health and work**

- (no number) « - » Development and support of good practice in enabling those with chronic illness to stay at work or return to the labour market.
- This includes rehabilitation programmes and other activities, particularly those which involve collaboration between the health care sector and the employment sector. The aim is to support the Health Strategy and the Community Strategy for health and safety at work 2007-2012.

# Not all priorities are open for projects

- Several « traditional » priorities do not have a call for proposals this year e.g. tobacco, alcohol, health inequalities, cancer
- Application form **will not let you choose** these priorities
- New: cardio-vascular diseases
- **Read carefully** the work plan 2010 – on EAHC web

# Criteria specified in work plan 2010 – 3.1



At least 60% of the total budget of the action must be used to fund staff.

At least 25% of the budget of the proposed action must be allocated to Member States with a GDP per capita (as published by EUROSTAT in its latest statistical report) in the lower quartile of all EU Member States.

A score of at least 5 out of 8 marks must be achieved for all the award criteria of the policy relevance block.

At least 10% of the budget must be allocated to organisations that have not received any funding under the Health Programme of the European Community in the past 5 years.



Besides, even if you are experienced in a specific field, it's likely that you don't have all the expertise needed to implement every action in the planned project.

Yet, finding good partners is not an easy task. Perhaps you don't know experts in other EU countries working in the same domain or you want to broaden the geographical coverage of your project.

The EAHC can help you a bit in this task. If you are looking for a project partner, this is what you can do:

- fill out and submit a **partnership proposal** or browse through the **proposals already posted**
- contact your **national focal point** for advice on partnerships
- check our **project database** and contact details of project partners



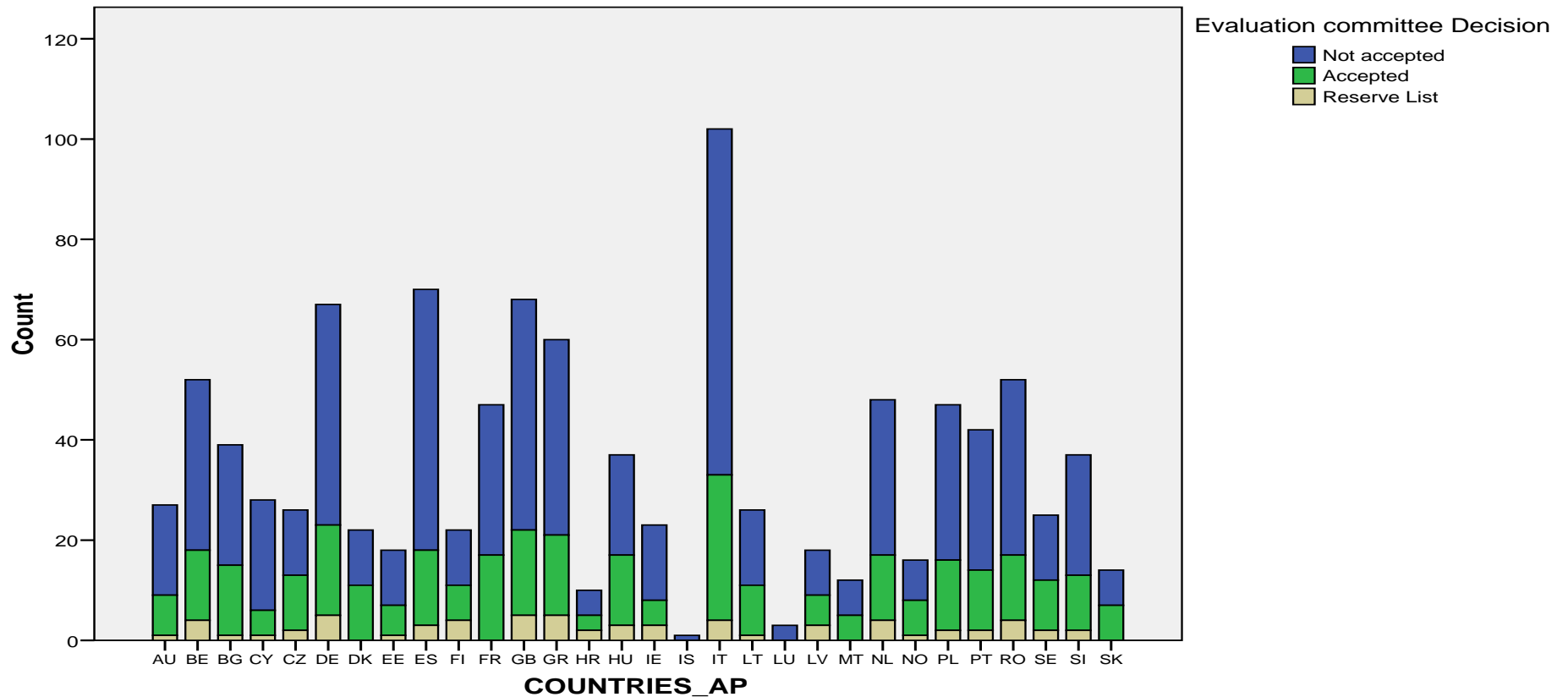
