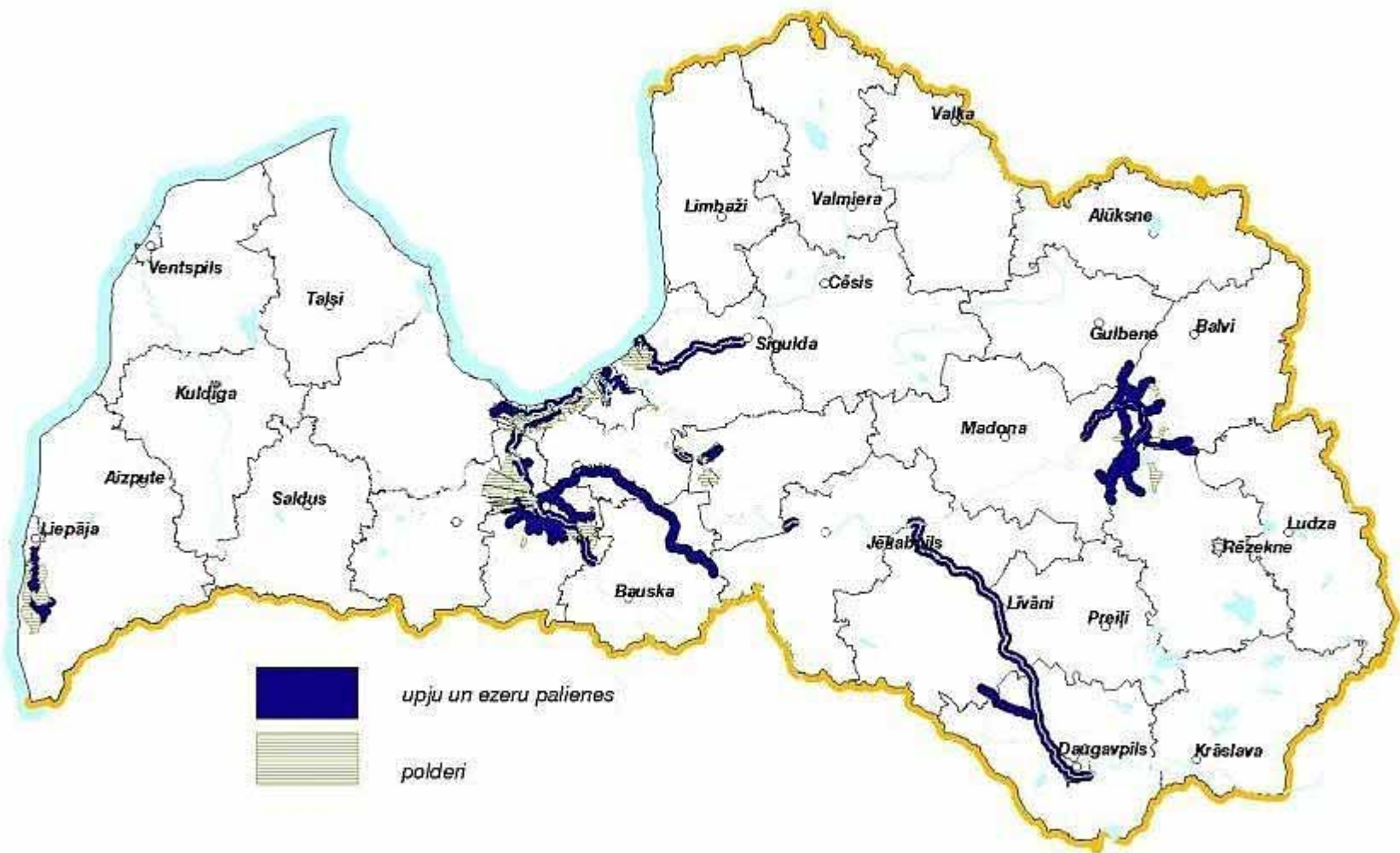

Fight flood – task 3


- setting up of joint cross border rescue team and strengthening its capacity
