HUMANITARIAN FUNDING FOR SYRIA

The EU as a whole is leading the international humanitarian response to the Syria crisis. EU Member States and the Commission together have mobilised over €210 million so far, more than 51% of the international response. The US counts for around 20% and other donors for just over 29%.
