## **Basic Facts**

- Establishment of a EU CP Cross Border
  Water Purification Module
- Project Partners: Austrian Red Cross (CO), Croatian Red Cross (AB1) and Slovenian Red Cross (AB2);
- Implementation period: 24 months (starting Jan 2010)
- Budget: EUR 321.000,- (75% EU, 19% CO, 4% AB1, 2% AB2)

# Why?

- Increased EU CP response capacity for rising number of extreme weather events and other disaster situations
- Austrian Red Cross has long-term experience (since early '90) in international water-treatmentoperations
  - e.g. 3 (joint) deployments in 2008 (Myanmar, China, Zimbabwe)
- Ongoing good co-operation CO and AB1 and AB2 in trainings, exercises and deployments
- Very positive experience in EU-projects (DG Env, DG ECHO...)



- Advanced technical training (1)
- Preparation course (1) for EU training courses
- Practical trainings (2) on field level
- Review workshop for identification/sharing of best practice/lessons learnt

#### **Deliverables:**

- Ad 1) 40 pax trained in 2 basic technical trainings (9.-11.4. 18.-
- 20.6.2010 and 04/2011)
- Ad 2) 20 pax trained in advanced technical training (06/2011)
- Ad 3) 15 pax trained in team leading and knowledge on EU CP mechanism (07/2011)
- Ad 4) Two practical trainings on field level conducted (18.-26.9/2010, 09/2011)
- Ad 5) Review workshop for best practice and lessons learnt (11/2011)
