

Objectives

- Development of a concept for a European approach for establishing and operating a "Reception, Evacuation & Forwarding Centre for EU Citizens in Emergency" during evacuation or repatriation operations
- Assuring of registration, onward travel to the home country and all issues in between with the respective Member State embassies and/or Foreign Ministries or any other Ministry of concern and/or the EU Delegation respective the embassy of the EU Presidency



Objectives

- The capacity should be up to 2.000 persons per day
- Special emphasis will be put on integrating vulnerable groups
- The staff will be trained and structured for serving as a multinational information platform
- The development and implementation plans will be shared with other organisations participating in the field of the Community Mechanism in the field of civil protection.



Actions

- Analyses of all subsequent steps of an evacuation
- Technical procedures will be developed
- Identify which kind of information is open for what type of player
- Identify special needs of vulnerable groups
- Collect experience and additional expertise
- Analyses of at least one questionnaire
- Organize and host one workshop (bring together actors in the field of civil protection and consular entities)
