### THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Re gulation (EC) No 1257/96 of 20 June 1996 concerning humanitarian aid<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 4 and Article 15(2) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In the hum anitarian aid sphere, tech nical as sistance in the theatre of operations and crisis situations serves to monitor humanitarian projects and plans and to maximise the benefits of aid for the victim s. Such technical assistance is provided from offices with the hum an and logistic resources needed to carry out the m ission. This financing decision follows on from previous decisions.
- (2) Until 2008 the tradition al type of DG ECHO o ffice set u p for a specific crisis was financed from the budget provided for in a decision taken in re sponse to a crisis, whereas the Regional Support Offices were financed under a specific financing decision.
- (3) It was decided in 2009 to bring the financi ng for all offices under a single decision, with a vie w to f acilitating the ir m anagement and obtain ing an over view of their budgets.
- (4) The continuity of this work should now be a ssured for an estim ated period of 15 months.
- (5) It is estimated that EUR 15 000 000 under Article 23 02 01 of the 2010 general budget of the European Union is needed to achieve the objectives of this Decision.
- (6) The Commission should implement the budget for these offices by direct centralised management in its departments.

- (7) This Decision constitutes a financing decisi on within the meaning of Article 75 of the Financial R egulation (EC, Euratom ) No 1605/2002<sup>2</sup>, Article 90 of the detailed rules for the implementation of the Financial Regulation (EC, Euratom ) No 2342/2002<sup>3</sup> and Article 15 of the internal rules for the implementation of the general budget of the European Union<sup>4</sup>.
- (8) In accordance with Article 17(3) of Council Regulation (EC) No 1257/96 of 20 June 1996 concerning humanitarian aid, the Humanitarian Aid Comm ittee gave a favourable opinion on 4 March 2010,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

### Article 1

- 1. The Commission hereby approves tota 1 financing of EUR 15 000 000 under Article 23 02 01 of the 2010 general budget of the European Union for the offices of the Directorate-General for Humanitarian Aid (ECHO).
- 2. In accordance with Article 4 of Co uncil Regulation (EC) No 1257/96 concerning humanitarian aid, the principal aim of this financing decision is to ensure the monitoring of humanitarian projects by providing technical assistance. This initiative will serve the following specific objective:
  - To equip ECHO' s technical as sistance o ffices with the lo gistics and necessary means to accomplish its humanitarian aid mission in the best possible conditions.

The total amount provided for in this Decision is allocated to this objective.

# Article 2

- 1. This Decision shall be implemented f or a period of 15 m onths, starting on 1 May 2010. The elig ible exp enditure sh all b e committed during the period of implementation of the decision.
- 3. The author ising of ficer may, where this is just tified by the humanitarian situation, extend the duration of the Decision for a maximum of six months, provided that the total implementation period does not exceed 18 m onths, in accordance with Article 90(4) of the detailed rules for the implementation of the Financial Regulation.

# Article 3

The Commission shall im plement the budget by di rect centralised m anagement in its departments.
