Specific exercise needs are, among others, the effective work in an international environment (including international guidelines), achieving high levels of interoperability, self-sufficiency, establishing effective communication systems, as well as fostering exchanges of information about equipment and performing command structures. Lessons learnt from the exercises shall be immediately integrated into the subsequent exercises. All exercises shall enhance the operational cooperation between the participating States' modules, TAST, as well as the EUCPT and also test the coordination of EU civil protection assistance in accordance with rules and regulations. The exchange of information of different equipment and of information of command structures and communication tools is also important. Moreover, the exercises need to recreate conditions of the international environment of mechanism interventions, including the interaction of modules, TAST, EUCPT with humanitarian and other relevant international actors.
