Background

Ukraine:

- Humanitarian challenges caused by conflict situation in Eastern Ukraine
- Experiences made by Ukraine RC in responding to civil unrest since Nov. 2013
- Provision of First Aid and Psycho-Social Support to wounded
- Increased planning and technical capacities needed
- Strengthening of auxiliary role of the Red Cross

Belarus:

- Red Cross works on mechanisms of prevention and response to emergencies
- Voluntary response units set up in every region by Red Cross
- Gaps in Crisis Communication between CSOs, local authorities and governmental institutions
- Improvement of skills and knowledge in Psycho-Social Support needed, lack of training materials available in Russian
- Extended First Aid during mass accidents, co-ordination and monitoring
