European Commission

Purpose

- All grant agreements concluded under current calls for proposals will end on 30 April 2008
- The new call for proposals will cover the BCS activity for 3 years: 1 May 2008 – 30 April 2011
- New call for proposals will cover all surveys and all Member States and candidate countries (Croatia, Turkey and FYROM)



Purpose (cont.)

- The objective is to conclude:
 - one framework partnership agreement per beneficiary for the full 3 years, and
 - 3 specific grant agreements covering 2008/09, 2009/10 and 2010/11



Indicative calendar

- Call to be published by June 2007 at the latest (after the modified Financial Regulation comes into force)
- Proposed date for submission of applications: mid September 2007
- Evaluation and selection of the proposals completed by **December 2007**



Indicative calendar (cont.)

- Two originals of the <u>framework partnership</u> <u>agreements</u> will be sent to the successful applicants for signature by **February 2008**
- On receipt of the signed originals, Commission will sign and return one original to beneficiary by mid March 2008
- Two originals of <u>specific grant agreements</u> will be sent to beneficiaries for signature by **mid April 2008**
- On receipt of the signed originals, Commission will sign and return one original to beneficiary by 30
 April 2008



Main technical requirements

- Use of the harmonised questionnaires
- Respect of a common timetable
- Survey design: largely left to the discretion of the institutes

New:

 Respect of the international guidelines on the conduct of BCS – will play a role in the selection of the proposals
