Description	<i>The ECSE summer school developed by 7 EU universities will guide a group of 35 international university students in environmental science to understand the influence of human activity on composition and functioning of various ecosystems characteristic (unique) of different European regions. With a multidisciplinary approach ECSE focuses on lessons learned from typical cases of environmental degradation, conservation and management in Europe, and will include the influence of economy and politics on environmental management. The local perspectives of solving environmental problems are taken also from the European perspective. The 2008-course comprises: (i) one week of theoretical preparation by means of e-learning, and (ii) 2 weeks of field excursions supported by lectures and seminars from the flood plain of the river Elbe (Labe) to the summit of the Giant Mts. (Krkonoše) in the Czech Republic. Study subjects will include ecology, zoology and botany, global change, brown coal mining, ecological catastrophes, flooding prevention, forest and soil restoration and remediation. Reports and posters on various aspects of the study area will be prepared by the students and assessed by means of a grading scale. A final report will include course assessment and evaluation as well as recommendations for future course development.</i>

Description	<p><i>The organic agriculture made a great progress in last few years. It became an accepted alternative to the conventional agriculture. However organic farmers have to fulfil many measures within their business, which as a consequence diminish the competitiveness of the organic agriculture. As a result, the organic agriculture could not fulfil its function without a state assistance.</i></p> <p><i>Organic agriculture represents for many farmers and villagers a new type of economic activity impractically all European counties. Due to this fact, courses concerning this activity have been recently involved into curricula of many agricultural universities and/or faculties; however the level and the content of teaching in not always the same.</i></p> <p><i>The aim of the proposed course is to unify different approaches to organic agriculture as practised in different European countries and inform the international audience about methods of teaching the subject of organic agriculture at the university level not only from the theoretical but also practical points of view.</i></p> <p><i>The participants of this course should be mostly pre-graduate students with already defined specialisation and study profile. Students will listen to the theoretical lectures and will participate in discussions in mixed groups formed from students from different European countries. They will visit some organic farms in the Czech Republic and companies, which support them as well. Participants (both students and teachers) will get to know more about possible development of organic farms in the participating countries and forms if financial and non-financial support of the farmers.</i></p>

Description	<i>Schwerpunkte des Projektes sind Bauvermessung und 3D-Modellierung im Bereich Denkmalschutz. Das Projekt setzt sich zum Ziel, das Studienfach „Computergrafik und -design“, an der Fakultät für Betriebswirtschaft in Karviná (Schlesische Universität in Opava) im Rahmen der Fachrichtung „Informatik für Manager“ unterrichtet, zu innovieren, indem man neue Einblicke in das Fach durch dessen Verknüpfung mit dem Bereich Denkmalschutz verschafft. Das Projekt ist auf Studierende und Lehrende von Hochschulen verschiedener Bereiche (EDV, Architektur, Denkmalschutz) und Teilnehmerländer (Schlesische Universität in Opava, Tschechien; Hochschule für Technik und Wirtschaft Dresden, Deutschland; Slowakische Technische Universität in Bratislava, Slowakei) ausgerichtet. Im Laufe eines zehntägigen Treffens, als Workshop konzipiert, werden die Projekt-Teilnehmer mit verschiedenen rechnerunterstützten Bauforschungsmethoden und deren Anwendung in der Praxis konfrontiert und gebeten, ein existierendes architektonisch interessantes Bauwerk als digitales 3D-Modell selbst zu entwickeln. Die Förderung einer stark fachübergreifenden und multinationalen Zusammenarbeit im Bereich „IT-Denkmalschutz“, der an der Schlesischen Universität in Opava sogar als eine neue Studienfachrichtung in Zukunft eingeführt werden kann, das Schaffen von besonderen Lern- und Lehrbedingungen, die an einer einzigen Hochschule in der Regel nicht angeboten werden, der Meinungs austausch von Lehrenden über Lehrinhalte, neue Lehrplanansätze, die Stärkung der Wettbewerbsfähigkeit der Studierenden im IT-Denkmalschutzbereich sind dabei als einige der angezielten Outputs zu nennen.</i>
