Description	<p>The objective of this IP is to educate master level students in both the theoretical and applied aspects in the field of health related and health enhancing physical activity (PA) in children. The content will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The academic rationale for the inclusion of sport, exercise, fitness and related health issues in the public health domain. - State-of-the-art scientific data on the physiological, epidemiological, psychological, sociological and social factors underpinning children’s participation in PA and sport - Methodological, ethical and practical issues which underpin scientific investigation and intervention in the field - Opportunities for students to obtain a European perspective on the topic, and offer them tools to evaluate how policy issues differ between countries. <p>An international multi-disciplinary approach will be adopted. Teaching methods will include lectures, seminars, practical workshops, student presentations and written exams. A prerequisite will be an active participation in an environment dealing with children and PA. The students will be provided with specific learning conditions not available in a single European institution, and the teaching staff will have international scientific reputations in the fields. Study material as well as virtual rooms for discussions between students and between students and teachers will be made available on a web site.</p>
