Description	<p><i>he school aims is to provide new tools to understand and interpret in a recreational and touristic way the environmental, historical and cultural amenities of the agro-forest landscape of Appennino Bolognese. The Savena, Idice and Sillaro valleys are particularly appropriate showing a multiplicity of agricultural landscapes, geological and ecological peculiarity as well archaeological sites and museums. The specific environmental traits of this central-eastern part of Bologna province qualify it as a borderland area, one of the most prominent geological frontiers of the entire northern Apennine region, which divides lands (and populations) that are very different from one another; an area with distinctive geological and hydrographic features ranging from the rocky bastions of the Pliocene Spur or the karstic phenomena of the southern part, close to the via Emilia, to the ophiolitic formations on the boundary with Tuscany. The area investigated also displays a wealth of historical and cultural landmarks such as the archaeological sites of former Etruscan and Celtic settlements. Soil study will be introduced as a new instrument to investigate the environmental complexity and the impact of ancient population on the territory. Modern cartography, remote sensing and GPS are some of the tools used to construct itineraries.</i></p> <p><i>Summer School is open to: Graduate students, preferably with a background in Agricultural, Development Studies, Environmental or Geological Sciences.</i></p> <p><i>Participants will be aiming at careers requiring competence in managing and planning agricultural, environmental and rural systems at various levels in local and national governmental, as well as non-governmental, organisations.</i></p>

Description	<i>Objectives: The objective of this course is to provide a full immersion course in both practical aspects and research in Screen Translation. The Course Screen Translation is an enormous market in the EU, providing translations not only for big screen and television products, but also for the huge DVD and videogames market and countless hypertexts for the World Wide Web. With the need for numerous and at the same time speedy translations the market requires an ever growing number of highly trained professionals in the areas not only of dubbing and subtitling (the two dominant forms of Screen Translation in Europe) but also in voice-over, the techniques used in documentaries. The course is aimed at both undergraduate and postgraduate students who wish to embark upon a career in the European Screen Translation industry, as well as those who are interested in researching the field. Main activities The course will consist of hands-on practical workshops in subtitling (both live for film festivals and recorded), dubbing and adaptation and voice over in which they will translate 'real' materials (eg a film, an episode of a cartoon etc.) and also theoretical, research based seminars. Expected Outputs Having been exposed to and practised the rudiments of subtitling, dubbing and voice over, participants should be qualified to enter the market at apprenticeship stage. Those wishing to embark on research will have been exposed to major issues in the area.</i>

Description	<p><i>The main purpose of the Intensive Programme (IP) is to provide students in urban sociology, regional and urban economics, geography and planning with an understanding of the different processes, institutions and actors at play in the metropolitan area. Different urban development patterns, planning strategies and policies will be presented and analyzed in detail in order to stimulate critical learning within a comparative framework.</i></p> <p><i>The proposed IP focuses on two major development projects in the metropolitan area of Milan: i) the Bicocca quarter, the redevelopment of a cluster of old industrial sites on the northern fringe of the city into a higher-education, R&D, cultural and residential area; ii) the development and consolidation of a green belt across the northern border of the city (PARCO NORD). These projects are representative of major transformational trends affecting metropolitan areas in Europe; their analysis will enable critical discussion of key issues including land use and rent, transportation, and environmental sustainability, as well as different planning tools and strategies.</i></p> <p><i>This IP specifically targets 2nd level degree (4th and 5th year of college) and Master's students. Course materials and results of case studies will be further disseminated by teachers and students upon returning to their home university, indirectly benefiting larger groups.</i></p>
