<b>Description</b>	<p>The idea of "International Entrepreneurship in the Baltic Sea Region" is to create a joint, highly specialised course by cooperation of an international group of lecturers and companies. The course of 4 ECTS will be introduced as a regular study programme at participating institutions. The target group are students who completed at least two years of studies and have demonstrated interest in international entrepreneurship, business management and who will follow their career in the Baltic Sea region. By working in international groups the participants will acquire practical intercultural skills and specialised knowledge in multidisciplinary fields that will increase their competitiveness on the labour market in the Baltic Sea region. They will learn how to start up a company acting on the international market, contracting with foreign partners, seeking to enter a new market. The course innovative features include combining theoretical knowledge and its straightforward application to current problems proposed by companies operating in the region. The cooperation of lecturers from three "old" and three "new" EU countries will also lead to develop their academic qualifications, enrich the methodology used in the class-work and result in preparing a set of teaching materials. <b>Description</b>	<p>The project combines three basic objectives of LLP in: didactical area providing solid theoretical and practical knowledge on sustainable water management, promoting international and intercultural communication between participants from different countries and developing friendly relations among students and teachers due to unique form of the project realisation which requires close cooperation in everyday duties. The participants of the project are the crews of 5 sailing yachts cruising across Mazury Lake District, listening to lectures and delivering presentations, making measurements of water quality, visiting scientific, historical and cultural sites of the region. Teachers and students from partnership universities will contribute to the realisation of the project discussing the topics of water management and lake protection, management of shores and spatial management in the protected areas. During the cruise each crew will collect water samples for analysis and relationships between these results and shore management, intensity of water exchange in lakes and inflow of river water will be determined. Before starting the course the invited teachers will elaborate lectures on water management which will be used during the course realisation. To acquire a comparative material, students will be obliged to prepare presentations on selected subjects referring to water management. All preparatory actions will be co-ordinated via Internet – by e-mails and audio-conferences. Similar audio-conferences will be organised after course completion, to discuss and summarise the project with teachers and students in participating countries. Completion of the project will reinforce the contribution of higher education to the process of innovation, improve the mobility of students and teachers in the region, improve the quality and increase the volume of cooperation via multimedia among universities, facilitate the development of innovative practices in education and training at regional level.</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>The aim of the IP “Biodiversity in the Mountains and its Protection” is to introduce students into problems of biodiversity assessment in the mountainous areas with different human impact (intensity and forms). It will be studied in Babia Gora and Tatra National parks on species, ecosystem and landscape level. The importance of natural versus anthropogenic factors will be considered. The course aims also in fostering the collaboration of students and tutors from different countries. The students will learn methods of studies, data elaboration, presentation and discussion in an international team. The biodiversity protection and assessment of the effectiveness of undertaken measures will be discussed. The particular topics are: natural drivers o biodiversity, calcareous versus crystalline substrate, altitudinal differentiation of vegetation, diversity related to different types of water courses, human impact on biodiversity, its forms, intensity and changes, primeval versus managed forest, how traditional forms of land use within the park contribute to the diversity, influence of tourists, practical problems of biodiversity protection. There will be following forms of teaching activities: lectures, field studies in small groups supervised by tutors, tutorials (elaboration and assessment of data), seminars – presentation of results by the representatives of working groups to the whole group. The guide in English will be elaborated and handed out to participants.</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>Today in Europe the curriculum of automotive training does not cover all the problems connected with environmental protection and safety of the vehicles. The young people who aim to become the future vehicle engineers should become aware and be trained in the design and service of future vehicles. There are tremendous changes ready to take place due to the introduction of new materials and technologies in the design and construction of vehicles. Also, it is very important that these future engineers familiarize themselves with the environmental restrictions on vehicles imposed on the member states by the European Commission. To this purpose the staff from twelve European universities will develop a joint module that will be taught to their students during the IP. These lectures will be supported by laboratory courses, workshops and visits in companies. The students will work individually and in teams. The result of their team work will be presented in PowerPoint presentations. The module courses will be available in paper format, CD-ROM and on the website of the IP project.</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>The main purposes of the project are: increasing the mobility of students and intercultural flexibility of their sociological imagination, fostering their interests into conflict resolution and conflict prevention, encouraging them to study modern crisis management technology; providing students with best practices of preventive diplomacy that is perceived as an alternative to preventive use of military force; creating a network of young Europeans concerned with soft aspects of international security. The target group are graduate students from Sweden, Germany, Poland, and Italy who might be willing to get a job in diplomatic service, in international or transnational institutions, and in private companies dealing on international markets.</p> <p>The main activities shall be seminars given in English by carefully chosen experts and playing by students a computer simulation game in crisis management.</p> <p>The expected results should be the enhancement of students' capabilities in team work, intercultural competence and communication in the art of negotiations and decision making in crisis situations, and to provide them with fresh knowledge on conflict prevention/resolution.</p> <p>The participants will receive an international certificate confirming their knowledge concerning the above listed topics. They shall be also allocated seven credits within the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS).</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>Information technology and communication play an important role in our society. Hence securing these concepts is vital to our society. The concrete application would be adopted in the field of security, namely security threats and assets, forensics and fraud detection.</p> <p>Students in information technology with a background knowledge in operating systems and networking are the target audience.</p> <p>The main activities would be in the area of prevention, detection and investigation. As ICT has a meaning of its own in each country it is important to compare the different views and perspectives. So the different approaches to security in the different countries will be compared in order to reach a consensus of what is a good working security practice. Using this consensus the students will work on a forensics case and in this process they will discuss and set the limits of what is ethical; which can be quite different depending on the student's cultural background. As expected output the students should be able to use and report on the consensus working practice.</p>
