Description	<p>The objective of the course is set as to train graduate students enrolled in agriculture, veterinary and related fields on current state-of-art of organic farming in Europe, compare with the World-wide trends and discuss issues affecting agronomic, environmental and socio-economic sustainability from farm to the global level. Organic agriculture principles and rules are defined by legislation however the practices vary from bio-intensive market gardening to extensive free range animal production. Although organic principles are compiled to achieve sustainability, the implementation does not always target a balance among major pillars but economic consideration receive a higher priority. The programme aims at sustainability assessment for organic farming –performed by integrating financial, environmental and social benchmarking and policy indicators and giving good and bad examples. Current marketing trends will be put forth and discussed in respect to supply chain management strategies, carbon foot printing and traceability. Comparison of organic farming development in Europe and Turkey will be compared as cases for bottom-up and top-to down approaches, respectively and relationship to philosophical and ethical issues will be also considered in the course. The socio-economic framework, including European policy issues, will be emphasised, as well as trade and marketing aspects in Organic Farming.</p>

As stated in the previous section the proposed IP is for the renewal of LEGIS IP. The first year of LEGIS IP was successful, achieving all its goals. One very concrete achievement is the definition of new project proposals. One of these proposals was selected by Erasmus for support. This is LAW&ICT Shared Virtual Campus project. The aim of LAW&ICT is to establish joint degree programs in the area of law and ICT. The proposed IP is expected to provide input to LAW&ICT VC project, including learning material.</p>
