<b>Description</b>	The Erasmus intensive programme "Introducing PanEuRhythm (PER): be Fit, Creative and Social with the Bulgarian System for Recreation" aims to present, develop and spread on academic level the Bulgarian experience in recreational sports and activities. PER is presented by summing up existing educational theory and practice: specializations at the National Sports Academy and three academic conferences "Paneurhythm as a System for the Harmonious Development of Self and Society". Study materials will be developed in conformity with the target group and the psycho-physiological character of PER, which combines movement, music, text, idea, social and natural environment. Basic activities include workshops for the study of PER's exercises and extra activities to develop social competences and creative expression, text reading of the songs of the exercises, exercising in natural environment, folk dance. The target group includes students trained to be sports teachers, recreation instructors, kinezytherapists or educators specialized in the field of sports. Expected results are study materials in the working language and partially in the languages of the partner institutions, which will spread using CD, internet and leaflet.

<b>Description</b>	<p>EFSS 2009 is a project for a third consecutive Intensive programme in semiotics. As the previous two editions, the main goal of the project is to develop new forms of interdisciplinary teaching in the field of semiotics, communication and social sciences. The IP consists in 10 working days of academic lectures, workshops and round tables and counts on the presence of 85 participants. The particular international environment, created by the presence of 65 students from 6 different European countries, provides unique conditions of multinational social interaction in knowledge exchange. Those conditions are particularly favorable to the theoretical content of the lectures and practically irreplaceable for the workshops and the exercises. Our purpose is to reach new level of quality of the teaching of semiotics and communication, unachievable separately in any of the participating universities. Although this field of study is not a subject of a separate master or BA program in some of the participating universities, in all of them it is an obligatory part of the studies in humanities, social sciences, political sciences or business communication. Our “target group” is the most affirmed or emergent scholars and the most gifted students and PhDs in the field, firmly convinced in the benefits of the international education and the future necessity to exercise whatever profession in the context of the knowledge, communication and mobility based society. EFSS as a model is incorporated in a project for a multinational PhD joint degree in Semiotics, presented by the Lapland University in Finland.</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>Das Intensive Programm (IP) ist auf dem Gebiet des Lasermarkierens. Das Lasermarkieren stellt einen sich rasant entwickelten Wirtschaftsbereich dar, der laut datenerhebung weltweit alle zehn Jahre eine Umsatz-Verdreifachung erfährt (Quelle: Optech Consulting).</p> <p>Das Proejkt zielt darauf ab, die Studierenden mit konkretem Einsatz der Lasertechnologie bekanntzumachen – Lasermarkieren, unterschiedlich von dem traditionellen Technologieverfahren, das seine Effizienz, Zuverlässigkeit, Schnelligkeit und ökologische Reinheit bewiesen hat.</p> <p>Das IP hat das Ziel, den Studenten theoretische und praktische Kenntnisse und Fähigkeiten auf dem Gebiet des Lasermarkierens zu vermitteln. Das IP erhöht den Wissenstand und die professionellen Fähigkeiten der Studenten und unterstützt dadurch die KMU, die einen starken Bedarf an Unterstützung beim Einsatz der innovativen Lasertechnologie haben.</p> <p>Im Laufe einer zweiwöchigen Sommerschule werden Studenten und Hochschullehrer aus Bulgarien, Deutschland, Griechenland und der Türkei mit den theoretischen und praktischen Aspekten des innovativen Lasermarkierens bekanntgemacht. Zwecks der Sommerschule werden theoretische und praktische Schulungsmaterialien ausgearbeitet.</p> <p>Durch Vorlesungen, Vorträge, Seminarübungen, Praktika und Firmenbesuche werden die Studenten mit dem gegenwärtigen Stand und Trend des Lasermarkierens bekanntgemacht. Der Inhalt der Sommerschule umfasst auch Diskussionen über aktuelle technische Problemstellungen der Unternehmen, die das Lasermarkieren einsetzen.</p> <p>Das IP in innovativen Lasern und Lasermarkieren sichert eine optimale und intensive Ausbildung in Lasermarkieren und trägt zur Aneignung konkreter aufbauender Kenntnisse und Kompetenzen bei.</p> <p>Der Austausch von Erfahrungen, Ideen, guten Praktiken, die Labor- und experimentelle Basis der aufnehmenden Universität sowie die ausgearbeiteten Ausbildungsmaterialien tragen zur Vermittlung von Kompetenzen bei, die das Wissen erweitern, das die Studenten während ihres Studiums an den Hochschulen bekommen.</p> <p>Direkte Projektbenutzer sind Studenten im Masterstudium in Optoelektronik, Lasertechnik und speziellem Maschinenbau aus Bulgarien, Deutschland, Griechenland und der Türkei. Indirekte Projektbenutzer sind Ingenieure aus den technologischen Abteilungen der KMU. Zum Zweck der guten Kommunikation zwischen den Projektpartnern wird die Errichtung eines Partnerkommunikationssystems geplant.</p> <p>Die Arbeit mit einem internationalen Team von Hochschullehrern wird zur Einführung einer europäischen Dimension in der Ausbildung der Studenten und zur deren Motivierung beitragen.</p> <p>Die Zusammenarbeit zwischen Studenten und Hochschullehrern aus Hochschulen verschiedener europäischer Länder ist eine Voraussetzung zur Entwicklung wissenschaftlicher Kontakte und künftiger Initiativen.</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>The events during the last decade have put a specific emphasis on the growing interdependence among countries. War conflicts in various regions around the world, the gas crisis in Europe, and the global financial crisis have had to a lesser or greater extent a negative impact on all countries. These events reminded the world that the wealth of all nations depends not only on the personal aspirations of their respective governments but rather on the collaboration of all nations around the globe to solve the seemingly domestic problems which have trans-border implications. Of course problems such as the protection of the environment, preservation of cultural heritages, peacekeeping, eradication of poverty, the international trade regimes, and the international financial stability, which have been defined as international or global public goods, are by no means modern concepts. Each one of them has its history which bears the marks of various individual and collective governmental decisions. History has proved that the individual efforts are not always sufficient and there is a need for collective action for achievement of positive results. There is also need for institutions and international code of conduct for the separate countries, companies and organizations, as well as the individual citizens.</p> <p>The intensive GPG programme aims to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- increasing the volume of student and staff mobility in Europe</li> <li>- improve the quality and increase the volume of multilateral partnerships among students and staff from the partner universities;</li> <li>- increase the intensity of utilizations of ICT in the educational process.</li> <li>- provide students with structured knowledge in the field of global public goods, the opportunities and mechanisms of their financing and institutional support.</li> </ul> <p>The programme targets senior students pursuing Bachelor degrees in Poland, Lithuania, and Bulgaria, who will be provided the opportunity to study in a multicultural foreign language environment. The programme events will be attended by about 30 students from the three partner universities. Their training will be conducted through lectures, presentations and workshops. The programme also includes field trips to cultural sites and companies. Training shall be provided by 3 or 4 foreign lecturers.</p> <p>The main activities included in the project are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- delivery of a lecture course on the topics included in the curriculum.</li> <li>- a workshop for presentation of individual student research papers;</li> <li>- a plenary discussion on the curriculum topics with the participation of lecturers, students and representatives of various businesses.</li> </ul> <p>Expected outcomes of the programme:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Improved communication skills in a multicultural environment;</li> <li>2. Improved knowledge in a specific area, dissemination of various teaching methods and techniques. Training of 30 students from the three partner universities.</li> <li>3. A collection of study materials based on the lectures given by the visiting lecturers.</li> <li>4. A collection of student research papers presented during the events.</li> <li>5. Certification of attendance.</li> <li>6. Creating a "blog".</li> </ol>
