<b>Description</b>	SPinSMEDE (Soil Protection in Sloping Mediterranean Agri-Environments) aims at providing basic tools to assess soil degradation and design soil protection initiatives in Mediterranean sloping areas. Rooted in both the thematic strategy for soil protection in Europe and the special environmental sensitivity of Mediterranean slopes, SPinSMEDE is targeted in post-graduation students from life / earth sciences and agricultural / forest / environmental engineering, in view their capacitation in such specific issue, therefore improving their current job opportunities. Programme comprises background subjects (soil degradation processes and assessment, soil protection measures design and implementation applying technical and socio-economic criteria), and case studies concerning land use typical of Mediterranean slopes (vineyards, olive groves, forests, shrubs). SPinSMEDE is a 82h "hands on" programme with 60h classes (theory and application exercises: computer, field and laboratory work), 15h self dependent study and one day field trip (7h). After course end, 80h long distance assisted work, enable students to present a written memory. Successful fulfilment of evaluation requirements awards 6 ECTS. Main results expected are: to increase number and qualifications of specifically trained technical staff to deal with soil protection matters; to progress towards stable and scientifically grounded training transnational platform specifically oriented to soil protection in Mediterranean sloping areas

<b>Description</b>	The Intensive Course FORREC objectives is to improve the quality of knowledge available to students and teachers on the recreation and tourism benefits of forestry and to increase the learning of techniques for delivering recreation and tourism benefits from forestry. Outputs of the COST Action E33 on Forest Recreation and Nature Tourism (European Science Foundation) will support the learning process. This Action involved experts of 26 European countries that during last four years shared their knowledge in 7 workshop and field trips on Scotland, Cyprus, Germany, Latvia, Slovakia, France, Poland and Portugal. Target groups are mainly graduate and undergraduate students from the applicant and partner institutions; local professors from other departments and schools, as well as local professionals and entrepreneurs of forest recreation or nature tourism will be welcome. Main activities are theoretical and practical lessons on economical and social values and benefits of recreation and nature tourism recreation and nature tourism demand, supply and behaviour patterns; and recreation planning, design and management. Two half day field trips in the surroundings involving Estonian local experiences will provide comparative data to support learning practices. Expected outputs are a learning process of excellence on forest recreation and nature tourism, quality reports and recommendations about local and regional recreational sector as well as better levels of training and knowledge amongst researchers, planners, designers, landowners and managers.

<b>Description</b>	<p>Cultural Heritage stands at the core of European integration, in its diversity, as recognised after Maastricht. Its relevance derives from its identitarian dimension and its economic importance in relation to tourism. The need to study, protect and disseminate the knowledge on European Heritage has long been recognised by all member states, and by UNESCO alike. Currently, several University diplomas are offered in Europe that deal with cultural heritage management. Yet, quality assurance is still to be introduced as a key concept in the Heritage sector. The applicants have collaborated in this direction and now intend to promote a new module on global quality management into the existing diplomas, in close articulation with the non-university sector. This has to be done at an European scale, given the current international dynamics of total quality in Heritage management, that risks to be implemented with little engagement of the academia. The IP is a teaching module, built within several curricula, corresponding to 3 ECTS. It aims at bringing together students and staff from various European Universities integrating various understandings of QA, including ICT. Students will discuss and train competences from the diagnosis of contexts to the preparation of management plans and evaluation systems.</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>The intensive program on Chemistry of Natural Products (CNP) was structured in a way as to integrate the various steps involved in the study of natural compounds. Different aspects related to the different natural compounds like biological function, biosynthetic pathways, structural characterization and also chemical synthetic procedures of those compounds or analogues with similar, or better, biological properties will be discussed. The expertises will be acquired in theoretical and practical classes (interpretation of practical cases and laboratory works) together with tutorial orientation and non-presential work. The knowledge of these subjects is certainly of interest to a wide group of degree or master students in the area of chemistry, biochemistry and food science and technology, leading to a better understanding of the thematic in CNP area. Written documents will be produced by the students in order to evaluate the knowledge acquired during the course. Also it will be guaranteed the recognition of the studies performed along the program by ECTS attribution. The information shared by the three country partners involved may result in the inclusion of the disseminated topics in their curricular studies plan or even in future Master programs to be developed in partnership.</p>
