Description	<p>Objectives The project objective is to create the frame for an open environment for internationally teaching and student's team in the field of bioanalytical methods applied in the life sciences, as demand for lifelong learning initiatives, with the purpose of allowing the exchange of good practices in teaching and practical activities at European level. Target groups Using ICT tools and practices, this Intensive Programme will make learning in the field of bioanalytical methods more attractive and it will assure the access of a big number of participants (master students, PhD students) as primary target group and teachers (indirect beneficiary) interested in strengthening links with life sciences and society. Main activities The project will be developed having as aim to promote rapid bioanalytical tests as demand for lifelong learning initiatives for the fields of life sciences. The level of knowledge of master students and postgraduates concerning the use of some bioanalytical methods will be evaluated. Combining ITC advantages, modern teaching materials in English concerning the bioanalytical methods will be elaborated. During two weeks will be organised an International Intensive Programme as Summer School "Bioanalytical Methods for Life Sciences", in Brasov, Romania where selected master students and postgraduate (PhD students) from different area from 5 countries will be trainees for an international teaching staff from 11 universities, in the field of the project. 6 ECTS will be provided at the end of the course using Diploma Supplement. All the team involved in project development will have contribution to the dissemination of the products and activities, using all the ways and means of involving master students, and other interested academic or non-academic media. Expected outputs Using the interdisciplinary knowledge transfer (emergency medicine, toxicology, genetics, chemistry, food chemistry, environmental protection), the project will contribute to the improving of teaching materials and methodologies concerning bioanalytical methods applied on life sciences in an international classroom environment. The European co-operation will make possible the obtaining of different didactical tools (e-books, multilanguages glossary, CD/DVD with video presentations for practical activities, web site with on-line material for teaching and evaluation) The students and teachers involved in mobilities in the frame of International Summer Course – Bioanalytical Methods for Life Sciences – (BMLS) will work in multinational groups, so they will benefit from special learning and teaching conditions not available in a single institution. All mobilities will be useful to identify and to develop a common EU basis on teaching/learning/evaluation/academic research in the field of bioanalytical methods applied to life sciences. The Intensive Programme BMLS will contribute to the dissemination of knowledge in rapidly evolving and new area of sensors, biosensors, immunoassay, biomonitoring and it will receive special consideration, especially due by their large application of different life sciences fields (food sciences and technology, environmental sciences, public health, biochemistry, genetics).</p>

Description	The IP "Transparency, Democracy and Global Governance. A European Perspective" aims at fostering the European transnational exchange of knowledge, competence learning and curricular development through an exploratory, innovative and multidisciplinary approach of the issues involved by the topic of emerging global governance in connection with democracy building in Europe and requirements for public transparency. The IP gathers together a team of 24 lecturers and 48 students from 5 European countries and 6 universities. Due to its multidisciplinary nature, the IP involves lecturers and students that are part of established educational programs and will benefit from a wide range of topics open for dialogue and debate from within fields like politics, international relations, inter-cultural studies, communication, journalism, media, organizational psychology, sociology, IT and business studies. The IP is framed as a summer-school that involves various activities from courses, key-speakers' sessions, professional debates, interactive activities, e-learning, competence building on the contemporary approach on global governance and democracy building in connection with the requirements for transparency. The expected outputs are targeted towards building a research consortium of universities that will build exploratory research on the topic and will implement joint educational programs, curricular development and enforcement of the knowledge based society through multiplying of expertise, publications, improving educational tools, extending the European partnership and generating best practices tools.

Description	<p>Objectives of the IP course are: better knowledge on competitiveness, innovation and entrepreneurship processes in nature based tourism services in Europe; overview on best practice cases for innovation and entrepreneurship in nature based tourism services in Europe; built up a practical toolbox for innovation, adapted for areas, sectors and enterprises which usually do not have a leading role in innovation processes; develop students' competences to deal with innovation and entrepreneurship in their own working environment; strength the networking between the partners; develop students' ability to think and work in an international context and to learn from others experience. The direct target group benefiting from the project results will be the Master level students and PhD students and the indirect target group will be the teachers, the universities curricula and the faculties. Also the indirect target group will be the tourism enterprises to transfer the knowledge and innovation. This intensive programme is for undergraduate and postgraduate students of business, tourism, environment, who are interested in new knowledge, international exchange, and, as much as possible, students with professional work experience. The Master and PhD students will be selected after bachelor level, work experience, case studies and ability to communicate. The selection criteria ponder equally the students' background and the students' potential to finally implement in their working environment the practical toolbox studied during the IP. The main activities are divided in three stages: Stage I: Students must prepare an innovative case study from their own country Stage II: 11 days of intensive course in Suceava, Romania: intensive course on special domains, work groups activities, field trips, excursions. Stage III: Each student will finalize his case study report. The final research will be presented to the company that represented his case study. The expected outputs of the project will be (all the material will be in English): tested curriculum of 11 days intensive course; teaching material related to this curriculum, edited and formulated into a uniform package, published in the web pages of the IP; a model of e-learning which could be adapted to be used in several different platforms instead of being institute specific; case study reports of the students, individual by each student, accompanied by a presentation; innovation plans of the students; a project website; a practical e-Brochure of the project in English language.</p>

Description	<p>The SSESIP-IP aims to improve and complete the academic professional training of the graduates in International Relations/European Studies/Political Sciences specialisations/Business Administration/Law. More specifically, it aims to support the bachelor students (1st cycle) in acquiring the core technical skills and the intellectual competences necessary to operate, with a high degree of autonomy and responsibility, in the globalized and security environment and required for properly managing the potential situations and contexts afferent to their future profession. They will be able to use cross-cultural communication skills and intercultural competences to compete in a global labor market and will be able to adopt a permanent knowledge seeking culture in their field of activity.</p>
