The Intensive Programme focus both on the theoretical aspects and on the practical implementations. Students will be immersed on the study of new technologies associated with user interfaces. They will be involved in international teams of at least two nations over an Aml scenario to work at the IP and at the home universities. The outcome will be an Aml scenario with proper user interfaces that will be improved and updated during the Intensive Programme with the new knowledge gained. The Intensive Programme includes an exam and a oral presentation of the projects. The students achieve ECTS-credits and grades.</p>

Such processes are characterised by higher safety and lower environmental impact as requested by the new European regulations. Therefore, also industrial people will be invited to attend the course what would help intensify the needed cooperation between academia and industry in this field. The IP will cover recent discoveries in this field along with the fundamentals of process design and examples of successful industrial applications. Priority will be given to discussions with the respective academic and industrial lecturers. This will allow the participants to focus on individual research projects in contacts with leading experts. In particular, the hands-on sessions will involve work on a process unit consisting entirely of micro-devices. <b>Description</b>	<p>A well-established group of European Law Schools aims to jointly develop and deliver an Intensive Programme on Transnational Law and how it affects Business and the Economy. From this perspective different area of study will be dealt with fields such as: European Law, Private International Law, Comparative Law, International Trade Law, Competition Law, Dispute resolution techniques, and the study of the International Organisations having an impact on international trade and business.</p> <p>The fundamental novelty of the initiative is its pluridisciplinary approach. Each year, in collaboration with entities closely concerned with business practice, the Network will choose a specific international trade issue to focus on. The programmed activities will include both theory classes (lectures) to learn the concepts and manufacturing technologies used in different countries with practices of instrumental analyses and sensory evaluation. <b>Description</b>	The course aims to strengthen students' knowledge about the concept of landscape and the way of doing landscape research. During this intensive course three totally different landscape areas (Catalonia in Spain, North Karelia in Finland and Presov region in Slovakia) and the newest viewpoints and approaches of landscape studies will be introduced to students. Special attention will be paid to the use of methods of both physical and cultural landscape studies in unified landscape research. After the course students will have a better understanding of the complexity of the concept of landscape and better facility to study different landscapes. The course also gives students competencies to carry out research in a multi-national group situation. The knowledge will be acquired by comparing the characteristics of this three case regions (Catalonia, Presov Region and Slovakia) at the seminars, group sessions and excursions during the course. The results will be discussed with the regional decision-makers at an international workshop as a part of the IP. Finally the results will be published in a open access system (for example on the web) and all this information will be send also to decision-makers and other regional organism can be interesting in it.

They have made a survey in order to test the advises given at the IP of 2007-2008. Students, in cooperation with the TA,TO,to's, specialised organisations and family hotels work out in the second edition guidelines and give special attention to some strategic strategies. During the third edition, students have to use the findings of the first and second IP editions (IP days in Rimini and Gerona) During the first year, students looked at the market position of small or medium sized family hotels and chain (big) hotels on the different markets (business / city / natural -leisure environment) in their own country. First of all the students had to find out in which way there is a (structural) cooperation with the Tour Operators (TO), Travel Agencies (TA) and tourist offices (to) of the region, the public administrations, and local community of the analyzed destination. In the second edition the students had to look for new strategic tools for small and medium sized hotels in order to survive on growing internationalised hotel and tourism market. 5 students per country/university, coached by 1 professor/lecturer did, on a multidisciplinary base, different analysis on the range of selected hotels in different tourism markets. In third edition, 5 students per country will work out with the cooperation of a few SM family hotels, in a very restricted way, some price/quality formulas, some room occupation strategies, and some adapted yield management strategies. They have to take into account the relationship with the tour operators, the travel agencies and the tourism offices and with the environmental situation and tourist activities The pros and cons of franchising and the position of ICT have to be focused too.. Students have to look after the individualised accents of the different hotels. The students will, if possible, implement the strategies, worked out in the first and second year, in a few selected and cooperative small or medium sized family hotels. The emphasis of the third edition lies on the innovative character of the strategies. At the IP days, the students used all the analysis, the experiences in order to compare the different situations of the different hotels on economical, environmental, and social perspectives, and location base in relation with the external parties and services. As in every edition, experts of the field guide students in their search and implementation of new strategies. In a presentation the students made their findings clear and work out advises for small and medium sized (family) hotels that were disseminated.</p>
